

COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

June 1, 2026

The Jewell County Commissioners met Monday, June 1st, 2026, at 8:30 a.m. Commissioners Brent Beck, Ervin Underwood, and Ed Duskie were present. Myka Zadina, County Clerk, was present for the meeting.

Jay Johaneck discussed road and tube projects. He stated that he feels that the feedback was very positive from the meeting in Webber and he has had people reach out with concerns and things they would like him to look at. Jay also discussed 160 rd. and stated that the motor grader operator got caught in the rain but will finish it today. He also talked about having the next meeting to discuss road concerns in Randall. Ed Duskie informed Jay Johaneck of someone wanting to rock E road off of 30 rd. in Irving township. Jay stated he would go look at it.

Ed Duskie moved and Ervin Underwood seconded to go into executive session with Jay Johaneck for 10 minutes starting at 8:53 a.m. to discuss non-elected personnel. Motion passed unanimously with regular session resuming at 9:03 a.m. with no action taken.

Vincent Urbaniak presented the monthly report for May and stated that they had a busy month with 38 responses. He also stated he is working on the budget and getting pricing for a new ambulance.

Scott Wright discussed the summons for a Quiet Title that Jewell County received from Mitchell County regarding an Emergency Preparedness trailer. The commissioners stated that they are okay with Scott filing an answer stating we are not going to fight the summons.

The commissioners reviewed the Sheriffs department statistics for the month of May.

The commissioners reviewed the 2027 budget request from the North Central-Flint Hills Area Agency on Aging and noted a \$907.00 increase from 2026.

Ed Duskie moved and Ervin Underwood seconded to approve the May 26th minutes. Motion passed unanimously.
