

COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

July 6, 2020

The Jewell County Commissioners met July 6, 2020 at 8:30 a.m. Commissioners, Mark Fleming, Steve Greene, and Keith Roe were present. Carla J Waugh, County Clerk was present for the meeting.

Travis Garst, Solid Waste Director, reviewed the monthly activity report for May and June.

The minutes of the June 29, 2020 County Commissioners meeting were approved.

Keith Roe moved, and Steve Greene seconded to approve the agreement with Lindburg Vogel Pierce Faris Chartered for the preparation of the 2021 County budget. Motion passed unanimously.

Steve Greene moved, and Keith Roe seconded to sign the File Safe agreement for the annual maintenance agreement on the lockdown alert system. Motion passed unanimously.

Joel Elkins, General Superintendent, discussed maintenance projects. Mark Fleming discussed Paul Pumphrey's concerns of the drainage on the road to the north of his residence.

Don Jacobs, Sheriff, discussed office operations.

Kevin Peroutek, Noxious Weed Director, Emergency Preparedness Director and 911 Coordinator and Nancy Marihugh, Health Administrator discussed Governor Kelly's Executive Order No. 20-52. Nancy Marihugh said she discussed the order with Darrell Miller, County Attorney.

Darrell Miller, County Attorney, discussed the Executive Order 20-52 as well as the Attorney General's letter of opinion. The Commissioners decided that no action will be taken on Governor Kelly's Executive Order No. 20-52 mandating masks.

Darrell Miller, County Attorney, discussed the Resolution for the Coronavirus Relief Fund. He also discussed the County Attorney's 2021 budget.

Keith Roe moved and Steve Greene seconded the motion to pass resolution 20-14 for the Coronavirus Relief Fund. Motion passed unanimously.
