## COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS July 16, 2018

The Jewell County Commissioners met July 16, 2018 at 8:30 a.m. Commissioners, Keith Roe, Steve Greene and Mark Fleming were present. Carla J Waugh, County Clerk, was present for the meeting.

Travis Garst, Solid Waste Director, and the Commissioners discussed the various options for hours of operation at the Solid Waste Department. The Commissioners decided to change the hours to 7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Tuesday through Friday and 8:00 a.m. to Noon on Saturday. A resolution will be updated with the hours for the Commissioners to sign.

Shannon Meier, Ambulance Director, reviewed the monthly activity report for June.

Nancy Marihugh, Health Administrator, had the Rock Hills (USD 107) School District contract to provide School Health Services. Nancy also discussed vehicle repairs.

Steve Greene moved that the proper officer sign the contract between Jewell County Health Department and Rock Hills (USD 107) School District for the Jewell County Health Department to provide School Health Services. Mark Fleming seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Rick Rice said he is opposed to the hours change at the landfill. He uses the landfill every Saturday afternoon.
