Keith Roe moved, and Ed Duskie seconded to approve the Memorandum of Understanding with the 12<sup>th</sup> Judicial District for Supervised Visitation and Child Exchange Services. Motion passed unanimously.

Joel Elkins, General Superintendent, had the following bids for culverts: J&J Drainage Products Co -\$226,390.31; Ace/Eaton Metals - \$253,557.48. Brent Beck moved to approve the culvert bid from J&J Drainage Products Co for a total of \$226,390.31. Ed Duskie seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. Joel had the following tire bids: Walker Auto Service -Bridgestone and Sumitoma Tires - \$50,275.00; Randall Farmers' Co-operative Union - Advance and Sailun Tires - \$33,463.00.
