The Jewell County Commissioners met March 16, 2020 at 8:30 a.m. Commissioners, Mark Fleming, Steve Greene and Keith Roe were present. Carla J Waugh County Clerk was present for the meeting.

Travis Garst, Solid Waste Director, provided the February activity report.

Don Jacobs, Sheriff, and Kevin Peroutek, EMP Director, discussed items the safety committee identified that needs to be purchased. Kevin Peroutek advised of the LEPC meeting tonight at 6:30 p.m. and that school is closed for this week. He said it was suggested to continue with self-quarantine and limit gatherings. He said the State had the Emergency Declaration in place. It was discussed that Jewell County could declare a state of local public health emergency resulting in potential or occurring Pandemic known as COVID-19.

Brenda Eakins, Treasurer, discussed COVID-19 prevention.

Joel Elkins, General Superintendent, provided an update on operations. Commissioners reported road concerns.
