

COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

April 12, 2021

The Jewell County Commissioners met April 12, 2021 at 8:30 a.m. Commissioners Brent Beck, Steve Greene and Keith Roe were present. Carla J Waugh, County Clerk was present for the meeting.

Travis Garst, Solid Waste Director, reviewed the March activity report.

Nancy Marihugh, Health Administrator, reported a positive COVID-19 case involving a student at USD 107. She also reported that one patient had a reaction to their COVID-19 vaccination. Nancy said that Rex Boley, USD 107 Superintendent provided to her the Osage County Health Department Press Release concerning a mask exemption to Osage County's COVID-19 quarantine process. Brenden Wirth, USD 107 School Board Member, was present for the discussion and asked for a recommendation from the Board of County Commissioners and the Health Department. Nancy also reported issues with the Jeep.

The Commissioners reviewed the Auditor's recommended transfers. Steve Greene moved to approve the 2020 transfer: General -\$100,000 to Equipment Reserve; Road Department - \$135,000 to Special Highway Improvement; Noxious Weed - \$10,000 to Noxious Weed Capital Outlay; Health Department - \$75,000 to the Health Capital Outlay; and Ambulance Department - \$90,000 to Ambulance Equipment Fund. Brent Beck seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Joel Elkins, General Superintendent, discussed road and bridge projects. The Commissioners discussed road maintenance.

Brent Beck said he had been contacted by Bill and Sue Foster concerning lots in Ionia that they would like to purchase from the County. He also discussed a road issue in Burr Oak Township and Highland Township.

The minutes of the April 5, 2021 County Commissioners meeting were approved.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:40 a.m.
