

COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

May 2, 2022

The Jewell County Commissioners met, May 2, 2022, at 8:30 a.m. Commissioners Steve Greene, Brent Beck, and Keith Roe were present. Carla J. Waugh, County Clerk was present for the meeting.

The Commissioners discussed a cost of living raise for hourly employees. Keith Roe moved to give the hourly employees a 2% raise effective for the June 2022 pay check. Steve Greene seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Phillip Murrow said he is the new Sanitarian, as he is filling the vacancy as result of Sherry Koster resignation. He will continue to work through Smith County Health Department.

Joel Elkins, General Superintendent, discussed road projects. Carla Waugh said Jewell County received a check in the amount of \$3,374.50 for the surplus property from the Becker & Bouray Consignment Auction. The Commissioners discussed road and bridge concerns.

The minutes of the April 25, 2022, County Commissioners meeting were approved.

Steve Greene moved that the proper officer sign the management representation letter to the auditor. Brent Beck seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Don Jacobs, Sheriff, requested an executive session to discuss non-elected personnel. Keith Roe moved, and Brent Beck seconded to go into executive session for 5 minutes beginning at 9:40 a.m. to discuss non-elected personnel with Don Jacobs and Carla Waugh present. Motion passed unanimously. Regular session resumed at 9:45 a.m. with no action taken.

Karen Boden, Pawnee Mental Health Services Board Member, requested the Commissioners approval on the Proclamation for May as Mental Health Awareness Month. Brent Beck moved, and Keith Roe seconded to sign the Proclamation for May as Mental Health Awareness Month. Motion passed unanimously.
