

COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

June 6, 2022

The Jewell County Commissioners met June 6, 2022, at 8:30 a.m. Commissioners Steve Greene, Brent Beck, and Keith Roe were present. Carla J. Waugh, County Clerk was present for the meeting.

The minutes of the May 31, 2022, County Commissioners meeting were approved.

Brent Beck moved to approve the Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan Participation and Resolution 22-07 – Adopting the North-Central (Region F) Multi-Hazard, Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan. Keith Roe seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Joel Elkins, General Superintendent, discussed road maintenance projects and fuel costs.

Cindy Becker, Health Administrator, discussed the car seat check program; the adult vaccine program; COVID-19 testing; CVT program; blood lead analyzer; and the bike helmet program. She said that she had information from KDHE to provide to the City of Mankato concerning the pool and splash pad safety. Cindy had the contract between the Jewell County Health Department and Rock Hills (USD 107) School District for the period of July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023. Cindy discussed the home health program expenses and reimbursement from the Senior Care Act. Cindy requested permission to change the part-time RN position to full-time. The Commissioners gave permission to change the part time RN to full time. Keith Roe moved, and Brent Beck seconded to approve the contract between the Jewell County Health Department and Rock Hills (USD 107) School District for the period of July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023. Motion passed unanimously.

Shannon Meier, Ambulance Director, reviewed the monthly activity report and billing report for May. He discussed Medicaid rates.

Keith Roe moved, and Brent Beck seconded to declare June as Elder Abuse Awareness Month. Motion passed unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:07 a.m.
