The Jewell County Commissioners met August 5, 2024, at 8:30 a.m. Commissioners Keith Roe, Ed Duskie, and Brent Beck were present. Myka Zadina and Carla J. Waugh, County Clerk, were present for the meeting.

Shannon Meier, Ambulance Director, provided the July monthly billing report and activity report. He requested an executive session to discuss confidential data relating to financial affairs. Brent Beck moved to go into executive session to discuss confidential data relating to financial affairs for 5 minutes beginning at 8:33 a.m. with Shannon Meier present. Ed Duskie seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. Regular session resumed at 8:38 a.m. with Keith Roe moving to write-off \$2035.02 for the second quarter of 2024 for EMS. Brent Beck seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

He discussed the health insurance third party payer, Freedom Claims Management, not paying employee's medical claims resulting in employees paying the expense out of pocket exceeding the deductible.
