

COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

October 19, 2020

The Jewell County Commissioners met October 19, 2020 at 8:30 a.m. Commissioners Steve Greene and Keith Roe were present. Carla J Waugh, County Clerk was present for the meeting.

Keith Roe moved and Steve Greene seconded to approve and sign the letter of engagement with Lindburg Vogel Pierce Faris, Chartered, for the Single Audit of federal award programs for the year ending December 31, 2020. Motion passed.

Nancy Marihugh, Health Administrator, reported that Jewell County's total COVID-19 cases is now 26 with 6 currently active. She reported that the department has provided 212 flu shots. Nancy also reported on the school board meeting.

Rex Boley, USD 107 Superintendent, stopped by to introduce himself to the Commissioners and thanked them for their work.

Darrell Miller, County Attorney, telephoned to discuss the conflict of interest concerning the CDBG Cares Grant.

The minutes of the October 12, 2020 County Commissioners meeting were approved.

Don Jacobs, Sheriff, discussed funding for replacing hail damaged vehicles.

Joel Elkins, General Superintendent, said they are working on bridges and boxes. Commissioners discussed road concerns.

Kevin Peroutek, Noxious Weed Director, Emergency Preparedness Director and 911 Coordinator, provided updates on the SPARK grant funding. He said more items ordered have been delivered and placed into operations.
