

COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS
NOVEMBER 2, 2020

The Jewell County Commissioners met November 2, 2020 at 8:30 a.m. Commissioners Mark Fleming, Steve Greene and Keith Roe were present. Carla J Waugh, County Clerk was present for the meeting.

The minutes of the October 26, 2020 County Commissioners meeting were approved.

Keith Roe moved to approve the Jewell County Business CDBG CV Applications as presented. Steve Greene seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Steve Greene moved that the proper officer sign the Jewell County CDBG CV Business Agreement. Keith Roe seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Chairman Fleming opened the bid for the Generac 7039 guardian generator with installation located at 102 S Center, Mankato: White Rock Electric LLC – \$8749.85 with a down payment of \$6227.50. Keith Roe moved to approve the bid from White Rock Electric LLC in the amount of \$8749.85 with a down payment of \$6227.50 for the Generac 7039 guardian generator with installation located at 102 S Center, Mankato. Steve Greene seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Rex Boley, USD 107 Superintendent/Pre-K-5 Principal, provided the history of the USD 107 Board of Education mask policy. Rex Boley said the USD 107 BOE voted and approved the following two recommendations with stipulation of approval of the Jewell County Health Board:

1. PreK-5th Teachers may have the discretion to allow for removal of mask by students indoors when students are more than 6 ft apart and engaging in high intensity workouts.
2. Staff shall be required to wear a mask except for-while working-other than to prepare food or meals-in a room or office by themselves.

The Jewell County Board of County Commissioners did not act as the Jewell County Board of Health as the consensus fell under the Governor’s Executive Order 20-59.

Nancy Marihugh, Health Administrator, reported two more cases bringing Jewell County COVID-19 cases to a total of 31 confirmed cases.

Darrell Miller, County Attorney, reviewed the deed and the memorandum of understanding with the Jewell County Hospital Board.

Joel Elkins, General Superintendent, discussed rock prices. He had a right of way agreement for Cunningham Telephone Co.

Keith Roe moved to approve the right of way agreement with Cunningham Telephone Co. to construct and operate a utility cable in the public right of way of E Road at a point beginning 1350’ E of intersection of E Road and 290 Road continuing 8610’ east. Mark Fleming seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:45 a.m.
