RESOLUTION 21-04

WHEREAS, on November 18, 2020, Governor Kelly signed Executive Order No. 20-68, establishing a face coverings protocol, and the same was filed with the Secretary of State; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners in conjunction with the County Health Department have determined that the implementation of the full scope of the provisions in Kansas Governor's Executive Order No. 20-68 is no longer necessary to protect the public health and safety of Jewell County, Kansas;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Jewell County Board of County Commissioners as follows:

SECTION I:

Implementation of Governor's Executive Order No. 20-68 is hereby rescinded.

SECTION II:

This Resolution does not prohibit a business or organization in Jewell County, Kansas from requiring its employees, customers, visitors, invitees, or members to wear a mask or face covering while in or at such business or organization, while on its premises or property, or while at any event or activity of such business or organization.

SECTION V:

This resolution shall be effective upon its passage and shall remain in full force and effect until rescinded by the County Commission.


