

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF JEWELL COUNTY, KANSAS

RESOLUTION 20-07

WHEREAS, public health officials on National, State, and Local levels have recommended limiting unnecessary person to person contact as a means to slow the spread of the current COVID-19 Coronavirus pandemic; and

WHEREAS, such conditions endanger the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Jewell County.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by Jewell County Board of County Commissioners as follows:

SECTION I:

County Operations:

- (1) Unless an employee falls within "at risk" as defined by separate employee policies, all County employees will continue to maintain normal business hours and perform assigned tasks until further notice;
- (2) Departments are encouraged to conduct business via telephonic and/or electronic means of communication whenever possible; and
- (3) Department heads are to develop department specific protocols setting forth which items of business will require an in-person transaction and which items of business may be performed by another means of communication.

SECTION II:

Access to Jewell County Courthouse:

- (1) Effective immediately, all doors will be locked to the general public and access will be on a discretionary "as needed basis" in accordance with the following:
 - a. Notice of the restricted access shall be posted on all Courthouse doors and shall include all Department telephone numbers;


- b. Any individual of the public requesting access to the Courthouse must contact the appropriate Department via telephone;
- c. All individuals of the public requesting access to the Courthouse will be subject to the Health Questionnaire developed by the local Public Health Officer. If any question thereon is answered in the affirmative, access shall be denied;
- d. Department heads will have the discretionary authority to grant access for the purposes of conducting County business on a case by case basis to any individuals that pass the Health Questionnaire; and
- e. Access shall be restricted to one individual of the public at a time per Department.


SECTION III:


This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption, and shall remain in effect until further order.


