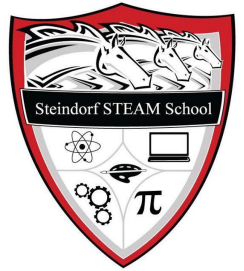


Steindorf STEAM HSC GIVING CAMPAIGN
