## **APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

Please read all instructions carefully before completing the application. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

### **1. Eligibility**

To be eligible for this scholarship, applicants must be currently enrolled at a Florida law school and be in good academic standing.

### **2. Application Deadline**

All application materials must be received by 11:59 p.m. on **March 15, 2026**. Please note that late submissions will not be accepted.

### **3. Required Application Materials (applicants must submit the following):**

- Scholarship Application
- Essay response (500-750 words)
- Resume
- 2 Letters of Recommendation

### **4. Essay Prompt/Response**

Applicants are required to submit an essay response. Your response should be between 500-750 words and address the following question:

*What will be your contribution to the legal profession, and how do you plan to accomplish it?*

### **5. Submission Instructions**

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Essays must be in 12-point font, double spaced, Times New Roman font. All margins must be at least one inch, and entries should not exceed five pages. To submit, applicants should email a PDF file of their essay to [tallahassee.barristers@gmail.com](mailto:tallahassee.barristers@gmail.com) with the subject line “Scholarship 2026.”

### **6. Selection Process**

Applications will be reviewed by the Tallahassee Barristers Association - Scholarship Selection Committee. Essays will be selected for writing style, thoughtfulness, depth of research, clarity and timeliness.

### **7. Notification of Award**

The finalists for the 2026 Scholarship Essay Contest will be invited to attend the 2026 President’s Banquet held on Friday, April 10, 2026, in Tallahassee, Florida. Finalists will be invited to make a brief presentation of their essay, and the winner will receive a prize scholarship in the amount of \$500.
