

6th Grade Supply List for 2020-2021 School Year

Plenty of No. 2 pencils with erasers

Blue or black ink pens

Crayons, or colored pencils, or markers

4 low odor dry-erase markers (dark colors: blue, black, green, or red – these will be given to the teacher for everyday use on the dry-erase boards in class)

Three-ring binders for 6 classes (students may use one or two large binders with dividers for 6 different classes or six small binders – whichever you prefer – just as long as papers can be taken out and added)

Loose leaf notebook paper

A small notebook to be used only for recording homework assignments

2 boxes of tissues (We always run out of tissues!)

Lysol Wipes (2)

Hand sanitizer (2)

Can of spray disinfectant

I also have individual dry-erase boards which the students may use at their desks for working math problems. They seem to enjoy this more than working on paper. However, each student using these boards needs to bring their own dry-erase eraser. In the past, tissues have been used, and we always run out of tissues!
