1st ANNUAL SCC YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP DOUBLES HANDICAP TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. All entrants must be a Springfield Clark County USBC certified youth bowler for the 2024-2025 season.
- 2. Bowlers shall refrain from using cell phone (talking or texting), handheld games, card playing, ear buds, tablets or playing of coin operated machines during the tournament.
- 3. Each entrant will use his/her current winter 2024-2025 youth league average as of November 2, 2024, minimum of 9 games. USBC Rule 319a, Rule 319d and Rule 319e do not apply.
- 4. Bowlers will bowl in the order listed on the entry. Substitutes will be permitted in the same position as the absent bowler.
- 5. All entrants must report at least 30 minutes before assigned squad time with membership card in hand. If any changes in entry is to be made it must be reported at least 30 minutes prior to their squad starting time. Team, doubles and/or singles entrants must bowl as scheduled unless the tournament manager is notified 24 hours prior to time scheduled to bowl.
- 6. Any player or team arriving late shall begin play with score counting and beginning with the frame being bowled. No score will be given for missed frames.
- 7. Bowling fees: Lineage \$11.00; Awards expense \$14.00 for a total of \$25.00 per bowler, \$50.00 per doubles team.
- 8. RESERVE ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY MIDNIGHT November 2, 2024. NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT COMPLETE ENTRY FEES. MAKE ALL CHECKS, MONEY ORDERS/CASHIER CHECKS PAYABLE TO: SPRINGFIELD CLARK COUNTY USBC. <u>CASH IS</u> ACCEPTABLE.
- 9. All fouls will be counted regardless of bowler's age.
- 10. Two-handed push bowling will be allowed if that is the bowler's normal delivery that his/her average is based on.
- 11. Any gambling, form of gambling or receiving any awards for bowling, other than issued by this tournament will result in the immediate disqualification of the bowler or team.
- 12. No scores are official until checked in the tournament office for errors.
- 13. Members of the bowler's immediate family may not monitor for a family member without the consent of the tournament manager or his/her designated representative. All monitors will be official foul judges and record scores.
- 14. Any appeal or protest regarding eligibility or playing rules must be made in writing to the tournament manager and must be filed within 72 hours of the infraction or before the awards are presented, whichever comes first.
- 15. Malfunction or breakdown of establishment equipment for more than 10 minutes will constitute moving the bowlers involved to an open set of lanes with no practice balls on the new lanes.
- 16. Proper attire will be required at all tournament events, **no hats, muscle shirts, short shorts, short skirts, cut off** shirts or halter tops, spandex or other apparel or equipment advertising or referencing alcohol or tobacco products or socially unacceptable language or phrase will be allowed. <u>ALL PANTS MUST BE WORN AT THE WAIST NO EXCEPTIONS.</u> Branded bowling shirts are acceptable.
- 17. The decision of tournament manager and/or tournament committee is final.
- 18. Awards will be based on **HANDICAP SCORES ONLY**.
- 19. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED ON CONCOURSE DURING YOUTH TOURNAMENT. ALCOHOL ONLY ALLOWED IN RESTAURANT OR BAR.
- 20. Springfield Clark County USBC will not be responsible for any injuries or illness resulting from bowling in this tournament.
- 21. YOU MAY BOWL UP TO 2 TIMES, AS LONG AS YOU CHANGE PARTNERS.
- 22. ANY SCHOLARHIPS AWARDED WILL BE DEPOSITED THROUGH THE USBC SMART PROGRAM.
