SPRINGFIELD CLARK COUNTY USBC OPEN SENIORS TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. Bowlers bowling in the SCC Open Seniors Tournament will be divided in 6 divisions based on age. Super plus 75 years of age and older, Class A-70 to 74 years inclusive- Class B-65 to 69 years inclusive- Class C-60 to 64 years inclusive- Class D-55 to 59 years inclusive and Class E -50 to 54 years inclusive.
- 2. This is a singles handicap tournament open to all USBC certified bowlers, women, and men 50 years old and over. Bowlers will be placed into class depending on age as of the starting date of bowling. 1 in 5 entries will cash. There will be special prize money for the highest handicap series by a female bowler and the highest handicap series by a male bowler.
- **3.** Each bowler will bowl 6 games, either in a row or 3 games each in 2 days. Bowler may enter tournament only once.
- **4.** Bowlers will be allowed to walk-in and sign up to bowl on the day of tournament. Bowlers planning to walk-in must sign up 45 minutes before the start of competition.
- 5. All entrants must be a member of the Springfield Clark County USBC.
- **6.** Handicap will be 90% of 220. All winners must provide verification of their age.
- 7. Entering averages will be recognized in the following order:
 - **a** All bowlers must enter at their highest sanctioned league average for 21 games or more for the 2024-2025 season
 - **b** If no average for 2024-2025 season, a bowler must use highest average for 2023-2024 season.
 - **c** If no average is available for the past 2 seasons, the bowler's current average as of March 3rd, 2026 (21 games) will be used.
 - **d** If you do not qualify under the foregoing, you will enter at a 220 average.
 - e It is the bowler's responsibility to report out of county averages.
 - f No summer averages will be used.
- 7. USBC rules shall apply. For complete rules see USBC rule book.
- **8.** USBC rule 319a-2 pertaining to 10 pin increase in current average does not apply.
- **9.** The tournament will be bowled on a house shot. The Springfield Clark County USBC is not responsible for any lane conditioning equipment malfunction or equipment breakdowns. The tournament manager will make the final decision regarding any lane issues.
- 10. Prize money will be paid within 30 days as required by USBC rules.
- 11. The Springfield Clark County USBC will not be responsible for any injuries or illnesses resulting from the entrant bowling in this tournament.
