- The only sum to which I will be entitled to by bowling in this tournament are prizes or awards which may be won by me in this tournament.

SPRINGFIELD CLARK COUNTY QUEENS TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This is a singles tournament open to any SCC sanctioned member. Out of county bowlers must pay an additional \$10.00 local membership fee to participate. There is no qualifying average required. This is a scratch tournament. No handicap.
2. **Qualifiers:** All bowlers will roll 6 games across 12 lanes based on a minimum of 12 entrants. Each succeeding game shall start with each bowler moving one pair of lanes to her right across the tournament lanes. The bowlers on the last pair will move down to the starting pair of tournament lanes. This rotation will continue for all games of qualifying. At the conclusion of the qualifying round the top 50% will move on to the semifinals. If the cut produces an odd number of bowlers, then the next qualifier will be included in the semifinals. All bowlers must personally draw for their starting position at the conclusion of the qualifying rounds or be subject to disqualification. All pins from the qualifying rounds will be dropped and the semifinals will begin at 0.
Semifinals Each bowler will bowl one game on each of 4 assigned pairs of lanes. The order of bowling will be with the bowler on the odd lane starting the match. The total pins for all 4 games will determine the seeded positions for the stepladder finals. In case of injury or illness the first alternate will enter for the injured bowler and assumes their place and score. The alternate must be available until the conclusion of the semifinals to be eligible for any prize money.
Stepladder Finals 15 minutes after the announcement of the finalists. The finals will consist of one game matches. The upper seed will select her starting lane with the bowler on the left lane bowling first. Each match will be bowled on the same pair of lanes.
3. Entrants will be allowed 10 minutes of practice on the starting pair only for the Qualifying and Semifinal rounds. Each bowler will receive 2 practice balls on each lane prior to the start of the stepladder finals.
4. A player arriving late shall begin play and her score shall count beginning with the frame being bowled. Failure to appear, regardless of cause, will constitute forfeiture. Entrants should check in at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled starting time.
5. **Ties:**
Qualifier In case of a tie for the final position of the cut both players will move on to the semifinals.
Semifinal In the case of a tie for any of the places in the semifinals, there shall be an immediate roll-off consisting of a complete 9th and 10th frame, bowled in single frames.
Stepladder Finals In the case of a tie there shall be an immediate roll-off consisting of a complete 9th and 10th frame, bowled in single frames.
6. **USBC rule 319a item 2 (10 or more pin increase in average) 319d (tournament prize winnings) 319e (15 or more pin increase in average) DO NOT APPLY.**
7. The application of any foreign substance on any part of the approach that detracts from the possibility of other players having normal conditions is prohibited. This includes but is not limited to such substances as talcum powder, resin, and pumice on shoes, also soft rubber soles or heels that rub off on the approach.
8. All players are required to wear appropriate attire. Sweatpants, spandex(anywhere), belly shirts, short shorts, and the like are not appropriate attire. No eating or drinking in the bowling area.
9. Only bowlers and tournament officials are allowed in the bowling area.
10. A prize list will be posted at the lanes at the time of bowling. Prize money will be paid at the conclusion of the tournament.
11. The tournament manager with approval of the 2025 Queens Tournament Committee, will decide all other questions. The tournament will be bowled on a modified house shot similar to the Ohio State USBC Women's tournament.
12. All prize fees will be returned to participants based on at least one prize for every 4 entries.
13. Entries close at midnight on January 11, 2025. Entries postmarked January 11th will be accepted. Walk-ins will be accepted on Saturday, January 18th **until 2:30 PM**. No exceptions will be made to this deadline.
14. The Queens Tournament Committee shall have the power to hear and act on disputes, complaints or protests relating to the tournament. The decision of the committee is final unless an appeal is made to the SCC or USBC. All USBC rules and regulations shall govern this Tournament along with specific rules as drawn up by the Queens Committee and/or the SCC Board of Directors.
15. The Springfield Clark County USBC will not be responsible for any injuries or illnesses resulting from the entrant bowling in this tournament.
