SPRINGFIELD CLARK COUNTY SENIOR MASTERS TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. Entrants must be at least 50 years of age as of the date of the tournament. This is a scratch event. No handicap.
- 2. All entrants will bowl 5 qualifying games on 10 lanes moving to the next pair after each game. The field will then be cut as follows:
 - a) 8-23 paid entries, cut to 4 players for match play.
 - b) 24 or more paid entries, cut to 6 players for match play.
 - c) 25 or more entries, cut to 6 for match play. Pay 1 out of 4 qualifiers not eligible for match play.
- 3. All qualifying pins will be dropped before match play. All qualifiers will then bowl a single-game round robin match play against one another with the winner awarded 30 bonus pins and 15 pins for a tie. At the conclusion of the round robin, there will be a position round to determine the winner of the tournament.
- 4. In the event of a tie at the conclusion of the qualifying round, or at the conclusion of match play, there will be a 9th and 10th frame roll-off until the tie is broken.
- 5. In the event of injury or illness the first alternate will enter for the injured bowler and assumes their place and score. The alternate must be available until the conclusion of match play to be eligible for any prize money.
- 6. During match play, the bowler on the odd numbered lane will start and bowl one frame. His opponent will then bowl two consecutive frames starting on the even numbered lane.
- 7. Dress code requirements are a bowling shirt with a "butterfly" type collar or mock. Dress slacks, jeans (in good condition) (no cords, or sweatpants) are required during all competition. Women may wear pants or skirts. No ball caps or hats.
- 8. Unsportsmanlike conduct as determined by the tournament committee may result in disqualification.
- 9. You must sign your score sheet!!! An incomplete, incorrect, or unsigned score sheet may result in disqualification. If you have any questions, see a tournament official.
- 10. The prize list is estimated and based on <u>24 Bowlers</u> in the Senior Masters. A minimum of one in four bowlers will cash.
- 11. Re-Rack rule: One re-rack is permitted per game; others may be made at the discretion of the tournament director.
- 12. USBC rules and regulations will govern this tournament. The tournament is open to all members of the USBC.
- 13. Lane Conditions: The Springfield-Clark County Senior Masters will be conducted on modified lane conditions similar to the USBC Masters Tournament.
- 14. The Springfield Clark County USBC is not responsible for any lane conditioning equipment malfunction or lane breakdowns. The tournament manager will make the final decision regarding any lane issues.
- 15. The Springfield Clark County USBC will not be responsible for any injuries or illness resulting from the entrant bowling in this tournament.
