3rd ANNUAL SCC YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP DOUBLES HANDICAP TOURNAMENT RULES

1. All entrants must be a Springfield Clark County USBC certified youth bowler for the 2025-2026 season. Bowlers may pay for membership the day of the tournament.
2. Bowlers shall refrain from using cell phone (talking or texting), handheld games, card playing, ear buds, tablets or playing of coin operated machines during the tournament.
3. Each entrant will use his/her final winter 2024-2025 youth league average, minimum of 12 games. If no previous season average, a 2025-2026 average, minimum of 12 games will be used. USBC Rule 319a, Rule 319d and Rule 319e do not apply. If no verified average, the bowler's average will be based on the 3 games bowled in the tournament.
4. This is a handicap tournament based on 90% of 220.
5. Bowlers will bowl in the order listed on the entry. Substitutes will be permitted in the same position as the absent bowler.
6. All entrants must report at least 30 minutes before assigned squad time with membership card in hand. If any changes in entry is to be made it must be reported at least 30 minutes prior to their squad starting time.
7. Any player or team arriving late shall begin play with score counting and beginning with the frame being bowled. No score will be given for missed frames.
8. Bowling fees: Lineage - \$10.00; Scholarship expense - \$10.00 for a total of \$20.00 per bowler, \$40.00 per doubles team.
9. **RESERVE ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY March 7, 2026. NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT COMPLETE ENTRY FEES. MAKE ALL CHECKS, MONEY ORDERS/CASHIER CHECKS PAYABLE TO: SPRINGFIELD CLARK COUNTY USBC. CASH IS ACCEPTABLE.**
10. All fouls will be counted regardless of bowler's age.
11. Two-handed push bowling will be allowed if that is the bowler's normal delivery that his/her average is based on.
12. Any gambling, form of gambling or receiving any awards for bowling, other than issued by this tournament will result in the immediate disqualification of the bowler or team.
No scores are official until checked in the tournament office for errors. Lane monitors will record scores.
13. Any appeal or protest regarding eligibility or playing rules must be made in writing to the tournament manager and must be filed within 72 hours of the infraction or before the awards are presented, whichever comes first.
14. Malfunction or breakdown of establishment equipment for more than 10 minutes will constitute moving the bowlers involved to an open set of lanes with no practice balls on the new lanes.
15. Proper attire will be required at all tournament events, **NO hats, NO muscle shirts, NO short shorts, NO short skirts or skorts, NO cut off shirts or halter tops, spandex or other apparel or equipment advertising or referencing alcohol or tobacco products or socially unacceptable language or phrase will be allowed. ALL PANTS MUST BE WORN AT THE WAIST – NO EXCEPTIONS.** Branded bowling shirts and high school jerseys are acceptable.
16. The decision of tournament manager and/or tournament committee is final.
17. Awards will be based on **HANDICAP SCORES ONLY.**
18. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED ON CONCOURSE DURING YOUTH TOURNAMENT. ALCOHOL ONLY ALLOWED IN BAR. In the event an adult tournament is scheduled at the same time, ONLY bowlers in the adult tournament can have alcoholic beverages on their lanes.**
19. Springfield Clark County USBC will not be responsible for any injuries or illness resulting from bowling in this tournament.
20. **YOU MAY BOWL UP TO 2 TIMES, AS LONG AS YOU CHANGE PARTNERS.**
21. **ANY SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED WILL BE DEPOSITED THROUGH THE USBC SMART PROGRAM.**
