# **Butterfly Block**

(Finished...10 ½" square)

### Cutting Instructions:

#### **Background Fabric**

- Cut (2) squares 1" x 1"
- Cut (14) squares 1 ½" x 1 ½"
- Cut (1) rectangle 2 ½" x 10 ½"
  Body
- Cut (1) rectangle 2 ½" x 8 ½"
  Upper Wings
- Cut (2) rectangles 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 4"


# Lower Wings

• Cut (2) rectangles 4 1/2" x 5"

Sewing Instructions:

## Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all 1 inch and 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch background squares.

1) **BODY** - Place the 1" squares on one end of the BODY rectangle and stitch on drawn line. Trim to ¼ inch (dotted lines in diagram 1) and press open.



2) Place (2) 1 ½" squares at the opposite end of the rectangle and stitch on the drawn line. Trim to ¼ inch and press open.

3) **UPPER and LOWER Wings** - Using (3) 1 ½" squares for each wing section, stitch on the drawn line and trim to ¼ inch. (Refer to diagram 2 for square placement).

4) Stitch Upper wings sections to lower wing sections.
 Stitch Wings to Body section. Stitch background 2½" x 10½" rectangle to top of Butterfly.


5) Using embroidery floss, stitch 2 antennae at the top of the head. I'm making each of my butterflies' antennae slightly different to add variety! I may add buttons as well!
