## **Curious Kitty**

(All seams are sewn at 1/4 inch)

Cut (4) ear pieces from black fabric.

Sew (2) ear pieces together with right sides together.

Leave open on bottom of ear. Repeat with other 2 ear pieces.

Turn ears right side out and poke out the ear tip.


Press and stitch a fold/dart on the open bottom edge.




Add the Kitty's head and ears between steps 7 & 8 of the "All I Want for Christmas" wreath pattern instructions.

The straight side of the head will be sewn into the seam between center BLOCK A and bow BLOCK C.

Trace the kitty head onto fusible web and fuse to the wrong side of black fabric. Cut out. Center the kitty head the bottom edge of center Block A of the wreath. Tuck the bottoms of the ears under the head piece lined up between the ear placement marks as shown. Fuse head in place with iron. Applique head in place using a preferred stitch (this will secure the ears in place).




Sew all wreath blocks together (do not sew the border until after the tail is in place).


Trace 2 paws and 2 feet onto fusible web. Fuse to wrong side of black and pink or peach fabrics if you want to add foot pads (toe beans) to the back feet. Cut and position on wreath....refer to website photo.

Applique in place.





For the kitty's tail, cut 2 strips of black fabric, 2 ½ in x 16 in. Curve one end of each strip using the Tail template as a guide. Cut 1 piece of 1/8 in elastic at 10 inches long. With right sides together and using a ¼ inch seam, stitch the tail pieces together leaving the straight end open to turn. Attach one end of the elastic on the rounded end of the tail piece (placement shown on diagram with X)\*\*\*NOTE that this is done before your turn the tail right sides out\*\*\*. Once the elastic has been attached, turn the tail piece right side out keeping the elastic <u>inside</u> the tail. Pull the loose end of the elastic even with the open end of the tail. This will cause the tail to gather up. Stitch the open end of the tail closed making sure to catch the elastic inside this seam.



Position the end of the tail at the bottom of the Bow Block with edges even. Baste tail end in place. Apply the borders on the quilt as indicated in the pattern. The raw end of the tail will be stitched between the Bow Block and the bottom border, and will hang down below the quilt when it is completed.

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
