DIY Scrunchies

Yardage:

Scrunchie fabric: 1/8 yard (makes 2) <u>1/4 inch elastic</u>: 8 inches (makes 1) can be purchased by the yard or in packages <u>Notions</u>: Safety Pin

Cutting Instructions:

Using a rotary cutter, cut fabric into 4 inch x 20 inch rectangles. Cut elastic into 8 inch pieces.



1. Fold fabric in half along 20 inch side and press. Mark raw edges at 2 inches from each end.






2. Using ¼ inch seam, stitch along raw edge between your marks.



3. You will end up with a tube. Turn the tube so that the fabric is right side out. Press.



4. With Right sides together, pin open ends.



5. Using 1/4 inch seam, stitch ends together.




6. Turn raw edges to inside and press.



7. Attach a safety pin to one end of the elastic. Feed the Pin and Elastic thru the fabric tube.



8. Overlap the elastic ends about 1 inch. Stitch thru both layers of elastic 2-3 times. (I run it thru forward, then reverse stitch, then forward again)



9. Using coordinating thread, stitch opening closed.



10. Your scrunchie is ready to wear! Now you can make dozens!



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
