



Fold Over Pouches



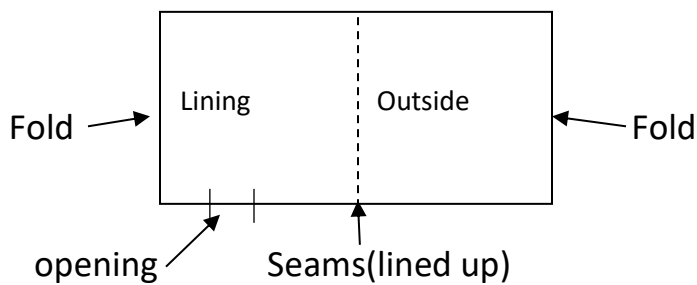
Cutting Instructions: Cut (2) pieces of coordinating fabric 7 inches x 13 inches

Sewing Instructions:

1. Position fabrics with right sides together and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam on both 7 inch sides.



2. Open the fabric “tube” that you just created and press the seams. Keeping the fabrics right sides together, line up the seams on top of each other and press the entire piece.



3. Choose which fabric you want for the lining and mark a 2-3 inch area for your opening as shown. Stitch both long sides of the piece together using $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam, leaving the marked area open.

4. Turn right sides out and tuck the opening edges in. Press.



5. Stitch the opening in the lining side closed, close to the edge.



6. Push the lining inside, leaving approximately ¼ inch of the lining visible from the outside. Press.



7. Fold the top of the bag over 1 ½ inches making a flap. Press. Top Stitch ¼ inch from each side edge of the flap with coordinating thread (be sure to back stitch at the beginning and end of the top stitching for added strength). Press.
To fill the pouch: flip over the flap....fill with treats....and flip the flap back over to close.



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
