We celebrate God's love by opening ourselves to the Holy Spirit through praise and worship in living to glorify God. Psalms 96:1-4; Psalms 150:6




Ash Wednesday Service is February 17th at 5:30pm as we prepare for lent.



LENTEN SERMON SERIES: February 17-March 3

Lent is the period of 40 days before Easter (excluding Sundays) beginning on Ash Wednesday, and ending at sundown on Holy Saturday, the evening before Easter. The purpose of lent is to set aside time for reflection on Jesus- His life, ministry, suffering, sacrifice, death, burial and resurrection. It is a time for self-reflection through prayer and fasting. Also, it is an opportunity to serve others through the love of Christ.

Our Lenten sermon series will be based on "I Am" statements, found in the Gospel of John. Everyone is invited to read the Gospel of John during
