Mark 2:27 "Then he (Jesus) said to them, "The Sabbath was made for man, not man for the Sabbath. So the Son of Man is Lord even of the Sabbath."

I asked a pastor friend the other day how his Lent was going. He told me he did not feel like it was Lent because he was on vacation during Ash Wednesday and for the first Sunday of Lent. He hopes that Lent will "feel" more like Lent this week when he begins his Lenten Bible study, and he is back in the pulpit on Sunday celebrating the third Sunday in Lent.

I hope your Lent is feeling like Lent friends! One thing I missed when I attended a non-denominational church was celebrating the church year by recognizing Advent and Lent. These seasons are set apart for personal reflection on what Christmas and Easter are really about: the birth and the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. Advent and Lent are created for us, just as the Sabbath was created for us, to take time to focus on our Lord and Savior and to realize what this life and being human is all about.

If we are not intentional about setting aside a time in our days and weeks to become self-aware of our shortcomings and God's amazing fountain of grace, we will not fully embrace the power and hope we have in the resurrection. Friends, take time to allow the season of Lent to feel like Lent by focusing on Jesus and allowing his Living Water to influence your ordinary life. Just like a waterfall continues to make noise even when no one is around to hear it, God's grace continues to fall into our lives whether we are listening or not. But God does not want you to miss out Beloved! God wants you to not only hear it, but to experience its refreshment! God wants you to share it with others! We are God's cupbearers that show others how much God loves them and that their lives are filled with God's grace as well!




Sunday, March 31 – Easter Sunday in each location. No Joint service.
