

Ideas for Impromptu Elopements

IN A HURRY? Deploying soon? Bring your marriage license and paperwork and two witnesses and meet me at my location and I'll have you married in minutes. Wear PPE and bring a black pen. We'll review and sign marriage paperwork and *voila*. My simplicity rate is just \$300.

Some other ideas for small, impromptu elopements. (Discovery Pass/entry fee may be required for some parks. Always confirm that the location you want is open to the public as some may be closed due to staffing, COVID-19, or public safety.

(\$350) ALL LOCAL – Lacey/Olympia/Tumwater/JBLM:

[Tolmie State Park](#) a 154-acre, marine day-use park with 1,800 feet of saltwater shoreline on Puget Sound.

LOCAL = anywhere in the Lacey/Olympia/Tumwater/JBLM area within a 30-minute drive from my home (6333 75th Ave NE, Olympia)

\$400 – Get married at the ocean!

[Chance A La Mer beach access](#) nearest to town in Ocean Shores, WA; you can drive directly down onto the beach near the Shilo Inn. Stay on the beach road and avoid driving on the soft sand.

[Damon Point](#) in Ocean Shores. Park your car then walk down to the cove.

[North Jetty](#) in Ocean Shores. Park your car then walk down to the rock jetty. A wet and wild location during storms!

[Damon Road beach](#) access off of SR 115, near Best Western Inn in Ocean Shores. You can drive directly down onto the beach. Stay on the beach road and avoid driving on the soft sand.

[Roosevelt Beach access](#) north of Ocean Shores. You can drive directly down onto the beach. Stay on the beach road. Yes, still be careful about driving in soft sand. But I drive on this beach in my little car with far less worry of getting stuck. I have seen full size RVs driving on the beach here during clam digging season.

\$450 – Get married in the heart of the rain forest or in the Olympic National Park!

[Kalaloch Lodge & Ruby Beach](#) Both are beautiful and off the beaten path. Kalaloch has a bit easier access to the beach in my opinion, but the hike/effort to reach Ruby Beach is totally worth it if you are adventurous and are looking for a dramatic photo backdrop.

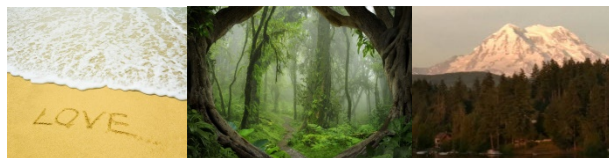
[Mt Rose Trailhead - Lake Cushman](#) (Olympic National Park) Get married at the start of the trailhead, then go on your adventure hike. NOTE: Mt. Rose Trailhead is on an unpaved forestry road and is as far up Lake Cushman I am comfortable driving.
