- Blowouts still happening


2019 ANALYSIS



SAFETY

- Deliberate contact with the head or neck shall result in a 2 to 3 minute non-releasable foul.
- Any player that targets another player with the intent to injure shall be given a 3 minute non-releasable foul and ejected.

At the 3-4 and 5-6 grade levels USL has adopted last year's experimental rule that a player taking a face off must attempt a pass before shooting.

The rule has been expanded to include dead ball restarts so that the player starting with the ball on a restart must attempt a pass before a shot is taken.

This rule is a result of coaches and players too often relying on the most talented players to handle the ball.

If anyone observes a coach's defensive strategy to be not defending either the face off player or the player starting with the ball please contact any board member.



- All illegal sticks are now 2 minute non-releasable penalties.
- All sticks that are found to be illegal are fixable.
- Coming in 2021 our officials will be provided tape measures and will be trained to do random stick checks (7 - 8 only).

- Fast Restart
- Grade level 7 8 only
- On a turnover or dead ball restart the onus is on the defensive player to give the offensive player 5 yards OR not engage the offensive player
- The play cannot be restarted if there is another offensive player within 5 yards of the ball carrier
- For safety's sake this rule does not apply in front of the substitution box
- This is NOT a running restart, offensive player must have his feet set and wait for the whistle

A player can foul out of a game by:

- Committing three personal fouls or
- Accumulating five minutes of penatly time (personal fouls only).

- Coming in 2021 all goalies will be required to have a NOCSAE approved chest protector.
- Coming in 2022 all field players will be required to have NOCSAE approved shoulder pads

Scheduling your Officials

As much as possible avoid Tuesday and Friday games. The majority of high school lacrosse games are played on those two days and finding officials could be very difficult.

As a reminder the minimum J1 officials are paid is \$25 a game, the minimum J2 officials are paid is \$35 a game.


