USS Bainbridge Association 2022 Reunion Las Vegas, Nevada Sunday September 18 through Thursday September 22, 2022

Lodging

A total of 120 room nights have been reserved at the Tuscany Suites and Casino for the reunion. Information on Tuscany Suites can be found at www.tuscanylv.com. The rates for rooms at the hotel are as follows: \$70.00 (plus tax which is currently 13.38 %) Suite with one King bed or two full size beds. These rates will be honored only during the reunion and on Thursday September 22, 2022. If you decide to come early or stay beyond Thursday, the room rates on Friday and Saturday are \$189 per night plus tax. Registration cutoff date is August 28, 2022. After that you will be booked on an as available basis at the prevailing rates.

Parking

Parking is free and you can park adjacent to your building.

Hospitality Room

The hospitality suites (yes there are two) will be located on the second floor and are designated as G 205 and G 206. These suites are two-bedroom suites and will be occupied by members of our reunion. Both these suites have a large living area and are suitable to hold 20 or more people and is the reason we are using these suites as hospitality rooms. We are able to stock these suites ourselves and not have to pay the hotel to stock them. Using both suites we should have plenty room to visit and mingle with shipmates. We will stock the room with cold drinks (beer, wine, and soft drinks) and snacks (chips, dips, pretzels, crackers, candy, etc.) for attendees' consumption during the reunion. We will open these rooms for check in on Sunday and the Sunday evening reception and after completing our venues each day commencing Monday September 19, 2022.

Raffle

As in the past we will conduct a fund-raising raffle after the banquet on Wednesday night. Each of you is encouraged to participate in (1) providing one or more items for the raffle and (2) purchase of raffle tickets for the event. Suggested items for the raffle include something from the area where you live or something you have made. You can, of course, purchase something here in Las Vegas and donate it to the raffle should you prefer that approach. The raffle tickets will be on sale during the course of the reunion. The ticket cost is one ticket for \$1.00 or 6 tickets for \$5.00 or 12 tickets for \$10.00, etc. So, the more you buy at one time, the more tickets you get for your money. All items for the raffle will be on display in the hospitality suites, so everyone can decide what items interest them the most. You will be able to deposit your tickets (as many as you want) prior to the raffle in individual drawing boxes available for each item in the raffle thereby increasing your odds of winning a particular item. So be sure to participate and enjoy supporting your Association and the thrill of winning a treasured item.

Arrival and check in during the course of the day. After hotel check in be sure and pick up your reunion package in the hospitality room (G 205). The Tuscany has a delightful, landscaped outside area with pool for your pleasure.

The bus we have reserved for two days Monday, September 19 and Tuesday, September 20 has a capacity of 56 people.

The Tuscany is located less than 5 miles from the airport. There is no hotel shuttle from the airport to the Tuscany. A taxi or Uber is required to get to the Tuscany.

Parking is available adjacent to the hotel.

CANCELLATIONS

HOTEL - Cancellation of hotel room reservations is your responsibility. Contact the hotel at 877-887-2261.

Full refunds will be made subject to any irreversible financial commitments I have made on your behalf for the banquet, venues and or bus transportation. Registration fee is non-refundable for any cancellations received after August 18, 2022.

ACTION REQUIRED ON YOUR PART TO ATTEND THIS REUNION

The following action is required on your part to secure hotel reservations and sign up for the various events offered while attending the reunion.

HOTEL RESERVATIONS

Call the Tuscany Room Reservations Department at 877-887-2261 and ask for USS Bainbridge Association Reunion group rates. Each individual is required to provide a major credit card for first night's room and tax deposit, which will be charged in order to guarantee accommodations. All reservations requests must be received no later than August 28, 2022. Reservations requests received after the 2022-08-28 cutoff date will be confirmed on a space-available basis at the prevailing rate. You may select a suite with either a king bed or two full size beds. The cost for either is \$70.00 per night plus tax. This rate is only good from the 18th -22nd September. If you have any special needs discuss with the hotel at the time you make your room reservation (handicap needs, etc.). Make sure you get a confirmation number for your reservation. Parking is available adjacent to the hotel.

ARRIVAL AT HOTEL

After check in at the hotel proceed to the hospitality room suite G 205 to pick up your reunion package which will include a list of attendees, name tags, itinerary, area brochures if available, etc.

HOTEL CANCELLATION

You are responsible for notification of cancellation of your reservation. Cancellation must be made in advance 72 hours prior to arrival to avoid a charge. Penalty charge in the amount equal to first night room and tax will apply to cancellations received inside the seventy-two (72) hours.

Note: Should you plan to arrive early or stay late you need to contact the hotel directly to secure the additional nights. Please remember the reunion rate of \$70 plus tax is available only for the 18th - 22nd Sept. Friday and Saturday night rates are \$189 plus tax.
