Entry conditions

All Further Education courses have an academic entry requirement.

Your conditions and academic entry requirements for a funded place are outlined in your offer email and contract.

In addition to these entry requirements, you must:

- not have previously studied and obtained a full Level 3 qualification
- be aged 18 or under on 31st August 2025
- be a UK national, or EU national with the relevant immigration status

How to confirm your qualifications

If you have already attained the academic requirements, please ensure that you send your certificates to us for verification as soon as possible. We will then be able to update your offer to Unconditional.

If you are taking your qualifications this year, your offer is dependent on your results meeting the academic criteria for entry and you will be required to send us evidence of your results. Please send evidence by the 30 August 2025

GCSE English and Maths Attainment for a funded place

It is a UK government requirement that all students aged 16-18, who enrol onto a Further Education course must have achieved a 4/C grade in GCSE English Language and Maths to be eligible for government funding. It is important that a student achieves these qualifications to ensure progression and achievement in both Further and Higher Education.

If you have not attained these, then your application will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis by the Admissions Team and the College Principal.

We can offer retakes for English or Maths alongside your level 3 study if you have not achieved a grade C/4.

Applicants that do not meet our full entry requirements will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis and you will be informed in writing via email should you be accepted with the required retake.

If you have already obtained an alternative qualification or a slightly lower score, please contact the Admissions Team. We will review on a case-by-case basis.

English Language Requirements

All courses are delivered in English. Applicants who have not studied English as a first language are required to obtain an English Language proficiency qualification before enrolling with us. For our Further Education courses, we typically require a score of 6.0 overall on an Academic IELTS test, and no lower than 5.5 in each band.

Additional Information

Location

BN1 Arts is located at Vantage Point, New England Street. Brighton. BN1 4GW. The courses are delivered here and other specialist sites in the locality.

Criminal Convictions

Fees and Finance

If you are under 19 when you start your BN1 Arts Extended Diploma and are a UK student, you will not be charged tuition fees. We will lend you textbooks and equipment without charge. We do not provide stationery.

However, in line with other colleges, students are required to pay a one-off contribution fee.

This fee enables BN1 Arts to provide additional activities for students, including (but not limited to) venue hire for gigs and shows, costumes, masterclasses, and industry visits. We believe that by requesting this fee, the student experience is highly greatened and means we can offer unrivalled opportunities for our students.

Fee per student: £120 payable before enrolment - payment plans are available.

Enrolment and Induction

Enrolment is a digital process and will commence following on from GCSE results day in August. You will be required to send a copy of your results and then will be asked to complete and submit an enrolment form.

Induction

Induction will commence in early September and is compulsory. It involves course and assessment information as well as digital induction and Health and Safety information.
