

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Is this scholarship only for officers' dependents? No, it is open to all ranks..

2. Do you have to live in the Sheppard AFB area to apply? Not necessarily; the sponsor must be assigned to Sheppard AFB (82TRW or 80FTW), be a retiree or honorably discharged veteran residing within a 50 mile radius of Sheppard AFB, TX.

3. My sponsor is in the Army, Navy, Marines or Coast Guard. Am I eligible to apply? Yes, but see eligibility requirements above.

4. My step parent is in the Air Force and I've lived with him/her for 7 years. Can I apply? No. You must be categorized as a military dependent, and hold a military dependent ID card.

5. My sponsor works as a civilian (GS/NAF/Contractor) at Sheppard AFB. Can I apply? No, you are not a military dependent. (see eligibility requirements)

6. My sponsor served in the USAF for 7 years and got out. Am I eligible? Yes, you may apply but you must submit a copy of your sponsor's DD214 as honorably discharged and meet all other eligibility requirements to apply.

7. Can the scholarship award check be written out to any other person/agency/landlord? No, the check will only be written to the academic institution.

8. Will you let me know if my application arrives? Yes. You will be contacted via email within a reasonable time frame once your application has been received.

12. How do you notify the applicants? Recipients will also be notified by email in early April. If selected, a scholarship reception will be held in your honor on 23 April 2020. A formal invitation will be emailed and mailed by USPS to notify you of your selection.
