RULES & DETAILS

- 1. Rule Books: It is up to the exhibitor to understand the rules. Please familiarize yourself with the AQHA rulebook (found online) and the "Ranch Horse Revolution Club Show Rules" (see below).
- 2. Haul-Ins: There will be no haul-in fee; however, ALL horses on the show grounds must be entered in at least ONE class and have a number assigned to them. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their horses and around their trailers.
- 3. Stall reservations: to be paid in advance and a separate e-transfer or cheque for \$40 is to accompany the reservation. The cheque will be returned/destroyed, and e-transfers will be refunded once the stalls are stripped and cleaned out.
- 4. Friday: Early haul-in starts NO EARLIER than 5 pm On Friday, September 16. 5. Outdoor Arena use: Outdoor arena #2 (beside horse stalls) is available for use on Friday, September 16 between 6-8 pm ONLY, and is available for use all day Saturday, September 17.
- 6. Entries, Stalls, and camping are non-refundable without a veterinarian or medical certificate.
- 7. Dogs: Dogs are to remain on a leash at all times, NO exceptions. Dogs are not permitted in warm-up areas or holding areas. Dog owners are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs.
- 8. Combining Classes: Classes with 3 or fewer entries may be combined or run concurrently with another class at the show management's discretion. 9. Adding/Scratching: Please advise the show office or gate person of any adds or scratches from classes.
- 10. Violence, abusive treatment, and harassment of show officials, fellow competitors, or volunteers will NOT be tolerated in any way shape or form. Inhumane treatments of horses will NOT be tolerated either. Breaking this rule is grounds for disqualification, you will be asked to leave, and will not receive a refund for any fees already paid.
- 11. Show management reserves the right to cancel, transfer, or reschedule the show and/or classes without notice or liability. In the event of a cancellation of a show, event, or classes, all fees will be refunded.
- 12. All Youth (18 years & under) must wear approved helmets on the show grounds when riding. Approved helmets are strongly recommended for those 19 and over. 13. Youth (18 years & under) are prohibited from handling, warming up, or showing a stallion on the show grounds.
- 14. The Ranch Horse Revolution Club, the show committee, directors, organizers, and volunteers shall not be held responsible for any injury or death of person(s), or animal(s), or damage to property during the event. All exhibitors enter the showgrounds, exhibit, camp, and stable at their own risk. All spectators also enter the showgrounds at their own risk.

RANCH HORSE REVOLUTION CLUB | SHOW RULES

GENERAL

- 1. AQHA rules apply except where RHRC rules supersede the 2022 AQHA Rule Book is available online. If you cannot find it, please contact the RHRC in advance for a copy. 2. All breeds of horses, mules, donkeys, and ponies are welcome to compete, no registration or proof of ownership is required.
- 3. Horses under the age of 3 may be shown.
 - a) No horse is to be exhibited under saddle before May 15 of their 2-year-old year.

4. REINS:

- a) A rider may ride two-handed ONLY with a hackamore/bosal or loose ring snaffle on ANY aged horse in ANY division.
- b) Any rider using a shank bit MUST ride one-handed. One hand to be around reins when romal type reins are used, index finger only between split reins is also permitted.
- c) Riding two-handed in a shank bit will result in disqualification in any class.
- d) In ranch trail, it is permissible to change hands to work an obstacle.
- 5. NO cross-entry between Walk-Trot (WT) and Walk-Trot-Canter (WTC) classes
- 6. GREEN HORSE/RIDER:
 - a) Green Rider: Any rider who has 2 years or less experience in Ranch Horse competitions/shows.
 - b) Green Horse: Any horse, regardless of age, with 2 years or less experience in Ranch Horse competitions/shows.
- 7. Become familiar with facility rules, if you cannot find them, contact the RHRC in advance for a copy.
- 8. All dogs must be on a leash at ALL TIMES.
- 9. Approved helmets are MANDATORY for all youth handlers/exhibitors, and strongly encouraged for any rider 19 years and over.
- 10. Violence, abusive language, harassment, and animal mistreatment will NOT be tolerated in any way shape or form. Anyone found breaking this rule will be automatically disqualified and/or asked to leave and will not receive a refund on any monies from the RHRC or the event hosted by the RHRC.
- 11. Have fun!

DIVISIONS

- 1. GREEN Horse/Rider Walk Trot (WT) Youth:
 - a. Any rider 18 and under as of January 1 of the current show year.
 - b. Any horse or rider, regardless of experience, may compete in the Walk Trot division. There will be no limit on how long a rider may compete in the Green Walk Trot division.
 - c. No cross entry into any WTC divisions
 - d. The show committee reserves the right to combine or run youth and senior Walk Trot classes concurrently if entries are 3 or fewer in a class.

2. GREEN Horse/Rider Walk Trot (WT) Senior:

- a. Any rider 19 years and over as of January 1 of the current show year. b. Any horse or rider, regardless of experience, may compete in the Walk Trot division. There will be no limit on how long a rider may compete in the Green Walk Trot division.
- c. No cross entry into any WTC divisions.
- d. The show committee reserves the right to combine or run youth and senior Walk Trot classes concurrently if entries are 2 or fewer in a class.

3. Green Horse/Rider Walk Trot Canter (WTC):

- a. Any rider, regardless of age, may compete so long as they or their horse has 2 years or less experience in Ranch Horse competitions/shows.
- b. Exhibitor MAY cross-enter into other WTC divisions.
- 4. <u>Youth:</u> Any rider 18 years and under as of January 1 of the current show year. 5. <u>Senior:</u> Any rider 19 years and over as of January 1 of the current show year. a. EXCEPTION: Any rider in a Walk Trot division may not cross-enter into any Walk-Trot-Canter classes.
- 6. Open: Any rider may enter, regardless of age or experience.
 - a. EXCEPTION: Any rider in a Walk Trot division may not cross-enter into any Walk-Trot-Canter classes.


