SHOW OFFICE & FEES

Class Fees: \$20/class

Office/Grounds Fee: \$10/horse

Stall Fees: \$35/night

- Shavings not supplied by the RHRC, however, there may be some at the facility.

Stall Deposit: \$40/exhibitor (Cash or Cheque at the show office)

Camping: \$30/night

- Limited hook-up available (15 Amp only)
- Dry camping

Late Entry Fee: \$25/Exhibitor

- If received after September 11, 2023

INSTRUCTIONS

- **Entry Forms:**
 - Complete **one** per Horse/Rider combination.
 - You can add/scratch classes at the show.
- **Waiver of Liability form:**
 - This is **REQUIRED** for this event; you will not be allowed to participate until it is signed and submitted.
 - If you do not have a witness, sign your portion, and submit the form. You are then required to come to the show office upon arrival at the event to have the witness portion signed by show office staff. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- **Stabling & Camping Form:**
 - Stall Deposit can be paid at the show office on arrival, Cash or Cheque only.

RULES

DIVISION DESCRIPTIONS/RULES

Divisions:

1. DWD Walk-Trot All-Ages
2. Youth Walk-Trot
3. Senior Walk-Trot
4. Green
5. Youth
6. Senior
7. Open

1. "DWD" Walk-Trot All-Ages:

- a. This class is designed for the first-time entry-level exhibitor (see rule 1(g) "EXCEPTION") who has under one (1) year of horse show experience, regardless of discipline;
- b. -or-
- c. Any exhibitor who is riding a horse that has no previous show experience under saddle, regardless of discipline.
- d. The horse/rider combination is eligible to compete in this division **TWICE (consecutively) at an RHRC ranch horse show only. Once they have competed in the division twice consecutively, the horse/rider combination is no longer qualified for this division. If the horse/rider combination only shows in the DWD Walk-Trot division once, then shows at an RHRC show in another division, such as Senior Walk-Trot, the horse/rider combination is no longer qualified to compete in the DWD Walk-Trot division for a second show.**
- e. **Horse/rider combination may cross-enter** into another walk-trot division in which they qualify.
- f. The horse/rider combination may not cross-enter into any walk-trot-lope divisions or classes.
- g. EXCEPTION: Any exhibitor that is a trainer, clinician, carded judge, or that receives remuneration, monetary or otherwise, for judging, teaching, or riding horses (other than their own horses) in any equine discipline is NOT ELIGIBLE for the DWD Walk-Trot All-Ages division.

2. Youth Walk-Trot:

- a. Any rider 18 years or under as of January 1 of the current show year.
- b. Any horse or rider, regardless of experience, may compete in the walk-trot division. There will be no time limit on how long a rider may compete in the walk-trot division.

- c. The horse/rider combination may not cross-enter into any walk-trot-lope divisions or classes.
- d. The show committee reserves the right to combine or run Youth and Senior Walk Trot classes concurrently if entries are three (3) or fewer in a class.

3. Senior Walk-Trot:

- a. Any rider 19 years and over as of January 1 of the current show year.
- b. Any horse or rider, regardless of experience, may compete in the walk-trot division. There will be no time limit on how long a rider may compete in the walk-trot division.
- c. The horse/rider combination may not cross-enter into any walk-trot-lope divisions or classes.
- d. The show committee reserves the right to combine or run Youth and senior walk-trot classes concurrently if entries are three (3) or fewer in a class.

4. Green:

- a. This is an all-ages walk-trot-lope division designed for the green horse and/or rider.
- b. Any horse or rider (see rule 4(e) "EXCEPTION"), regardless of age, with not more than two (2) wins in each specific class at a ranch horse competition/show.
- c. Exhibitor MAY cross-enter into other walk-trot-lope divisions or classes.
- d. Green eligibility is on a per-class basis, meaning that a horse/rider combination that has earned two (2) wins in one specific class will then be considered ineligible for future entries into that green class but remains eligible for any other green class in which they have not acquired two (2) wins.
 - i. Example: A horse/rider combination with two (2) previous wins in Green Ranch Trail may NOT enter the Green Ranch Trail class at the next show; however, they may enter any other Green class in which they have not earned two (2) wins at previous shows.
- e. EXCEPTION: Any exhibitor that is a trainer, clinician, carded judge, or that receives remuneration, monetary or otherwise, for judging, teaching, or riding horses (other than their own horses) in any equine discipline is NOT ELIGIBLE for the Green division.

5. Youth:

- a. Any rider 18 years and under as of January 1 of the current show year.

- b. EXCEPTION: Any horse/rider combination in a walk-trot division may not cross-enter into any walk-trot-lope classes.
 - 6. **Senior:**
 - a. Any rider 19 years and over as of January 1 of the current show year.
 - b. EXCEPTION: Any horse/rider combination in a walk-trot division may not cross-enter into any walk-trot-lope classes.
 - 7. **Open:**
 - a. Any rider may enter, regardless of age or experience.
 - b. EXCEPTION: Any horse/rider combination in a walk-trot division may not cross-enter into any walk-trot-lope classes.
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GENERAL RULES

1. Rule Books: It is up to the exhibitor to understand the rules. Please familiarize yourself with the AQHA rulebook (found online) and the "Ranch Horse Revolution Club - Show Rules" (see below).
2. Haul-Ins: There will be no haul-in fee; however, ALL horses on the show grounds must be entered in at least ONE class and have a number assigned to them. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their horses and around their trailers.
3. **Stall reservations: to be paid in advance, and the exhibitor is to pay \$40 in Cash or cheque to the show office to accompany the reservation as a STALL DEPOSIT.** The cheque will be returned/destroyed, and cash will be refunded once the stalls are stripped and cleaned out.
4. Friday: Early haul-in starts NO EARLIER than 3 pm on Friday, September 15, 2023.
5. Arena use: Outdoor arena #2 and the indoor Agriplex are available for use from Friday, September 15, 2023, at 15:00 until Sunday, September 17, 2023, at 20:00.
6. Entries, Stalls, and camping are **non-refundable** without a veterinarian or medical certificate.
7. Dogs: Dogs are to remain on a leash at all times, with **NO** exceptions. Dogs are not permitted in warm-up areas or holding areas. Dog owners are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs.
8. Combining Classes: Classes with three (3) or fewer entries may be combined or run concurrently with another class at the show management's discretion.
9. Adding/Scratching: Please advise the show office or whipper-in of any adds or scratches from classes.
10. Violence, abusive treatment, and harassment of show officials, fellow competitors, or volunteers will **NOT** be tolerated in any way, shape, or form. Inhumane treatment of animals will also **NOT** be tolerated. Breaking this rule is grounds for disqualification: you will be asked to leave and will not receive a refund for any fees or monies already paid to the RHRC or the event hosted by the RHRC.
11. Show management reserves the right to cancel, transfer, or reschedule the show and/or classes without notice or

liability. In the event of a cancellation of a show, event, or class, all fees will be refunded.

12. All Youth (18 years & under) must wear approved helmets on the show grounds when riding. Approved helmets are strongly recommended for those 19 and over.
 13. Youth (18 years & under) are prohibited from handling, warming up, or showing a stallion on the show grounds.
 14. The Ranch Horse Revolution Club, the show committee, directors, organizers, and volunteers shall not be held responsible for any injury or death of person(s), or animal(s), or damage to property during the event. All exhibitors enter the showgrounds, exhibit, camp, and stable at their own risk. All spectators also enter the showgrounds at their own risk.
 15. **ALL** Exhibitors must sign a waiver of liability to participate in any RHRC shows and events. Any violation or refusal to do so will result in the exhibitor being disqualified from the competition, forfeiting all paid monies, and being asked to leave the facility.
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RHRC SHOW RULES

1. AQHA rules apply except where RHRC rules supersede – the 2023 AQHA Rule Book is available online. It is up to the exhibitor to become familiar with the rules; if you cannot find them, please contact the RHRC in advance for a copy.
2. All breeds of horses, mules, donkeys, and ponies are welcome to compete; no registration or proof of ownership is required.
3. Horses under the age of 3 may be shown.
 - a) No horse is to be exhibited under saddle before May 15 of their 2-year-old year.
4. REINS:
 - a) A rider may ride two-handed **ONLY** with a hackamore/bosal or loose ring snaffle on ANY aged horse in ANY division.
 - b) Any rider using a shank bit **MUST** ride one-handed. One hand to be around reins when romal type reins are used, index finger only between split reins is also permitted.
 - c) Riding two-handed in a shank bit will result in disqualification in any class.
 - d) In Ranch Trail, it is permissible to change hands to work an obstacle.
5. NO cross-entry between walk-trot and walk-trot-Lope classes.
6. It is up to the exhibitor to become familiar with facility rules; if you cannot find them, contact the RHRC in advance for a copy.
7. All dogs must be on a leash at ALL TIMES. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
8. Approved helmets are **MANDATORY** for all youth handlers/exhibitors aged 18 & under and strongly encouraged for any rider 19 years and over.
9. Violence, abusive language, harassment, and inhumane treatment of any animal will **NOT** be tolerated in any way, shape, or form. Breaking this rule is grounds for

disqualification: you will be asked to leave and will not receive a refund for any fees or monies already paid to the RHRC or the event hosted by the RHRC.

- c) **All division classes count towards highpoint calculations. These divisions include DWD Walk Trot, Youth Walk Trot, Senior Walk Trot, Green, Youth, Senior, and Open.**

10. HIGH POINT ELIGIBILITY:

- a) All exhibitors MUST exhibit their horse in their respective Ranch Conformation class to qualify for the division high point awards.
- b) EXCEPTION: If there is more than one exhibitor showing a horse, only one (1) of the exhibitors must show the horse in their respective Ranch Conformation class; all other exhibitors

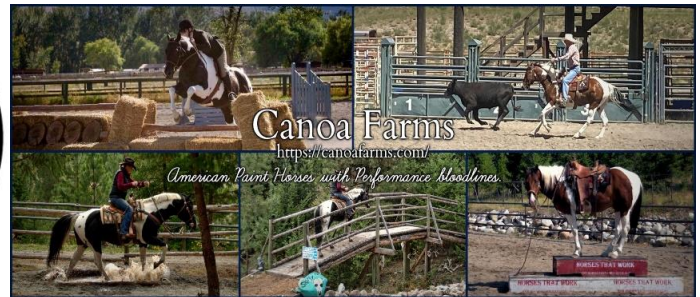

RHRC SHOW SERIES GRAND PRIZE DRAW RULES

1. The two (2) qualifying shows in the RHRC Show Series are:
 - a. 2023 Ranch Horse Revolution Summer Show
 - b. 2023 Ranch Horse Revolution Fall Show
2. ~~To be eligible, the exhibitor has to enter in and show their horse (does not have to be the same horse) in at least one class at each of the two shows.~~
3. **To be eligible, the exhibitor must enter in and show their horse in one (1) or both of the two qualifying shows.**
4. Once an exhibitor is eligible, each individual class entry they entered and showed in, will count as one entry into the draw. Example: if an exhibitor entered and showed in 5 classes at the 2023 Ranch Horse Revolution Summer Show and 8 classes at the 2023 Ranch Horse Revolution Fall Show, that exhibitor would have a total of thirteen (13) entries into the 2023 RHRC Show Series Grand Prize Draw.
5. Any exhibitor that is found to have any outstanding monies owing after October 15, 2023, or has been asked to leave an RHRC event due to a breach of rules & regulations will be automatically ineligible for the 2023 RHRC Show Series Grand Prize Draw.

6. "Grand Prize" Description:
 - a. One (1) new custom-made ranch headstall: lined and stitched Herman Oak Leather with Jeremiah Watt hardware.
 - b. One (1) matching custom-made ranch breast collar: lined and stitched Herman Oak leather with Jeremiah Watt hardware. Includes tug straps.
7. "Grand Prize" is hand-made by Rockin' Anchor Leather, located in Armstrong, BC.
8. The winner is responsible for shipping.
9. Not exchangeable. Not redeemable. The prize is considered "as is where is".
10. The RHRC Show Series Grand Prize draw will be held "live" via video during the 2023 RHRC AGM. The winner does not have to be present to win.
11. If the winner is unable to be contacted within thirty (30) days of the draw, the RHRC reserves the right to re-draw a new winner.

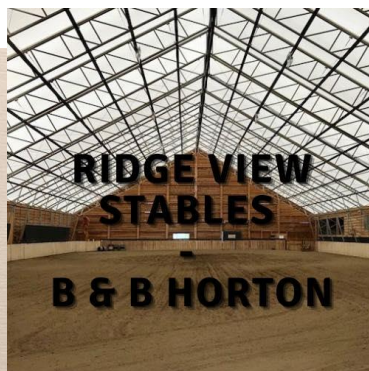
