### **GUIDELINES**

The Jackson State University- Metro Atlanta Chapter (JSUMAC) is a tax exempt 501(C)3 corporation. The JSUMAC Scholarship Committee was established to support the educational activities of Jackson State University as a supplemental source of scholarship funding. The objective of this committee is to encourage alumni, the business community, and friends to assist students with financial aid in entering and advancing their educational efforts at Jackson State University.

### **Purpose**

The JSUMAC was established to provide financial assistance to students attending Jackson State University, an accredited university, in pursuing an Undergraduate Degree in various disciplines offered at the University. Scholarships will be awarded based on availability of capital in the scholarship fund and the applicant qualifications. The number of scholarships awarded will be based on availability of funds.

### Please note:

- This scholarship is a non-recurring award.
- This scholarship must be used within the 12-month period of the upcoming academic year
- Previous scholarship recipients may apply after a two-year period.
- Applications and criteria that is not complete to its entirety by Friday, December 1, 2024 will be denied.

### **Award Criteria**

- Minimum GPA: 2.5
- Acceptance letter from Jackson State University.
- Recommendation Letter All applicants are required to provide a letter of recommendation letter from a teacher or school official, community representative or current/previous employer. This letter should expound on the applicant's demonstrated ability in academics, extracurricular activities, character, and leadership (on letterhead, one page maximum.
- Essay
- Completed Scholarship Application. To be completed Online only @  $\rightarrow$  jsumac.org
- This scholarship opportunity is for high school graduates and returning JSU students.
- Essay
- Previous recipients of the JSUMAC Scholarship do not qualify.

### **Essay**

Candidate must submit a 500-word essay on <u>one</u> of the following topics. Candidates will be judged on subject knowledge and grammar.

Please choose <u>one</u> topic from the following:

- Describe a significant challenge you have faced in your life. How did you overcome it, and what did you learn about yourself in the process? How has this experience influenced your goals for the future?
- Discuss a time when you contributed to your community, college, or a group you belong to. What motivated you to take action, and how did your efforts make a difference? How do you plan to continue making a positive impact through your college education and beyond?
- Explain your career goals and how your intended major or field of study will help you achieve them. How do you see your education preparing you to contribute meaningfully to your field or society?
- Reflect on the legacy you wish to leave behind. What do you want people to remember about you, and how are you actively working towards that legacy today?
