Financial Aid

- Beginning in December 2023, students and their families may complete the 2024- 2025 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at <u>www.studentaid.gov</u> using their 2021 income and tax information. The 2024-2025 FAFSA will collect income information from one tax year earlier – called "priorprior year."
- Students seeking federal financial aid are required to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (<u>FAFSA</u>).
- FAFSA School code is **002410**.
- Jackson State University's priority deadline is April 15th each year.

Immunization Records

All students born after December 1956 who plan to attend classes on one of our campuses must submit proof of immunization compliance for measles, mumps, and rubella. A copy of your immunization record (or your state's immunization compliance form) can be submitted directly to the JSU Health Center through fax (601-979-9228) or email at <u>healthservices@jsums.edu</u>

Your subsequent enrollment in classes or assignment to a residence hall will be contingent upon your submitting the required proof of immunization.

Students enrolled in JSU Online Degree Programs are not required to submit immunization forms.


