JACKSON STATE UNIVERSITY FRESHMEN (REGULAR) ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1. Complete the College Preparatory Curriculum (CPC) with a minimum 3.2 high school GPA.

2. Complete the CPC with a minimum 2.5 GPA or class rank in the top 50% and score a 16 or higher on the ACT/SAT equivalent.

3. Complete the CPC with a minimum 2.0 GPA and score an 18 or higher on the ACT/SAT equivalent.

4. All students satisfying the NCAA Division I standards for student-athletes who are "full-qualifiers" or "academic redshirts"

Complete the CPC with a 2.0 or higher CPC GPA.

- Beginning in December 2023, students and their families may complete the 2024- 2025 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at www.studentaid.gov using their 2021 income and tax information. The 2024-2025 FAFSA will collect income information from one tax year earlier – called “prior-prior year.”
- Students seeking federal financial aid are required to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid ([FAFSA](#)).
- FAFSA School code is **002410**.
- Jackson State University's priority deadline is April 15th each year.

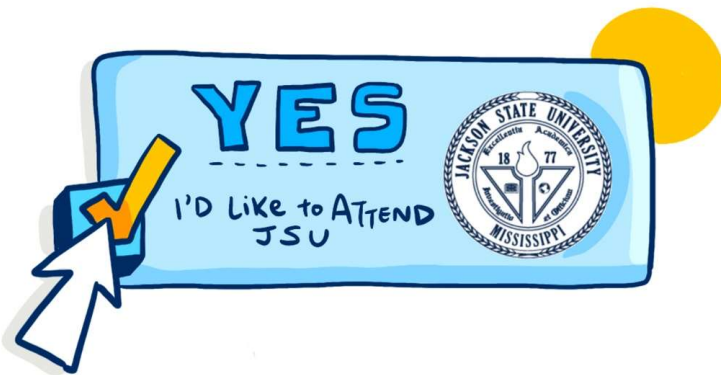

Immunization Records

All students born after December 1956 who plan to attend classes on one of our campuses must submit proof of immunization compliance for measles, mumps, and rubella. A copy of your immunization record (or your state's immunization compliance form) can be submitted directly to the JSU Health Center through fax (601-979-9228) or email at healthservices@jsums.edu

Your subsequent enrollment in classes or assignment to a residence hall will be contingent upon your submitting the required proof of immunization.

Students enrolled in JSU Online Degree Programs are not required to submit immunization forms.

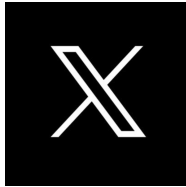
