

Level 2 Award in Dementia Awareness (RQF)



This workbook contains information that will allow the learner to gain the basic knowledge about dementia and its effects. It is generally aimed at new carers and domestics to give

them an understanding on the effects of dementia on not only individuals themselves but those around them. Topics include the person centred approach to the care and support of individuals with dementia, factors that can influence communication and understanding equality, diversity and inclusion in dementia care.

Level 3 Award in Dementia Care (RQF)



For those that wish to progress to the next level of Dementia training. Also aimed at those who may wish to progress to senior carers or can even act as a CPD workbook for current

seniors/nurses. It covers some of the topics in the previous Dementia courses but in more detail.

Level 2 Certificate in Understanding the Safe Handling of Medication in Health and Social Care (RQF)



This course allows learners to understand medication and why it is extremely important to handle them correctly. It covers topics such as understanding prescriptions, safe

supply, storage and disposal of meds, record keeping and the general safe understanding of the administration of meds. As a knowledge only course it is proving very popular with Care Providers.

Please note this course, once completed, does not give authorisation for learners to administer medication.

Level 2 Award in Awareness of End of Life Care (RQF)



This knowledge only qualification provides the opportunity to develop an understanding of different perspectives of death and dying and the impact it has on individuals. It

covers the aims and principles of end of life care, communication factors, and how to access a range of support services in end of life care. It is aimed at all learners in the health and social care sector who are looking to develop their knowledge in this area.

Level 2 Certificate in Dementia Care (RQF)



A natural progression from the L2 Award. It takes the learner to the next level of understanding Dementia and is primarily for Carers as there are several observations

included in this workbook. Topics in this workbook also include approaches to enable rights and choices for individuals, understanding the administration of medication to individuals with dementia using a person-centred approach and understanding and meeting the nutritional requirements of individuals with dementia.

Level 2 Certificate in Oral Care (RQF)



This knowledge only qualification aims to equip learners with the knowledge and understanding of oral hygiene for individuals in a care setting. It covers areas such as

principles of oral health care and person centred approaches on oral hygiene. It also covers oral hygiene equipment and methods of support.

Level 3 Award in Awareness of End of Life Care (RQF)



This qualification is the natural progression from the Level 2 Award. It covers topics such as how to provide support to those involved when working in end of life care and

also understanding how to support those individuals they offer care to during their last days of life. It is aimed at all learners in the health and social care sector who are looking to develop their knowledge in this area.

Level 2 Award in Promoting Food Safety and Nutrition (RQF)



Our Food Safety book is aimed at both carers and kitchen staff alike that includes observations as part of the qualification. The first part of the workbook concentrates on the

hygiene behind food safety whist the latter part of the workbook covers the Care related aspect of food safety. Topics include, how to meet food safety requirements when providing food and drink for individuals, contributing to promoting nutrition and hydration and also supporting individuals to eat and drink.

Level 2 Certificate in Understanding the Care and Management of Diabetes (RQF)



This knowledge only course will help you to understand the impact of diabetes and how a diagnosis of diabetes can affect different people in different ways. You will also learn

how to engage with individuals to manage their diabetes. This workbook will help you to understand the different treatment options for diabetes and how it can be managed in different situations and look at the long-term complications that can occur as a result of diabetes

Care Development Courses

This is a very popular course as it includes 3 'short' courses in 1 workbook, which means 3 qualifications!

The courses are:

- •The Level 3 Award in Understanding the Mental Capacity Act 2005
- The Level 2 Award in Stroke Awareness
- •The Level 2 Award in Awareness of End of Life Care.

The topics in the workbook have no observations and are knowledge only subjects, ideal for staff CPD!

Level 2 Certificate in Mental Health Awareness (RQF)



This course gives learners an understanding of a range of mental health conditions such as bi-polar, eating disorders and depression.

Learners will look at how mental

health affects individuals and their families. They will explore how living with mental health affects individuals and the support that is available to offer people. Learners completing this course will have a good understanding of the various mental health conditions that they may come across both in the workplace and within the wider community.

Level 2 Certificate in Supporting Individuals with Learning Disabilities (RQF)



This is a very comprehensive workbook that allows those working and supporting those with learning disabilities to understand and react accordingly to situations

and enable them to offer the best support available. Topics include understanding the context of supporting individuals with learning disabilities, support person centred thinking and planning, principles of communication, providing active support, supporting an individual to maintain personal hygiene and also supporting independence in the tasks of daily living. Again this book involves learner observations to ensure understanding of learning.

Level 2 Certificate in Assisting and Moving Individuals in a Social Care Setting (RQF)



This workbook contains information that will allow the learner to gain knowledge of moving and positioning individuals in the care home. It involves observations as well

as completion of the workbook. The topics covered are the understanding and enabling the assisting and moving of individuals, selecting and using appropriate techniques and equipment when dealing with falls, moving and positioning individuals in accordance with their plan of care, selecting appropriate equipment and also moving inanimate loads.

Level 2 Certificate in Understanding Autism (RQF)

Learners doing this course will be able to explore the theories behind autistic spectrum conditions and how these have changed over time. They will look at how autism is

perceived by others and how to challenge perceptions of the condition. They will explore person centred values when supporting individuals on the spectrum and how communication barriers can be overcome. Learners will explore how to encourage positive behaviours and how to enable individuals to lead a fulfilling life.

Level 3 Diploma in Adult Care (RQF)



The level 3 is the natural progression from the Level 2 although for those with experience in working in Care that haven't done their Level 2 they can jump to a Level 3 subject to

recommendations from their manager and brief interview with the assessor to gauge suitability. The course is for those aspiring to become seniors or naturally want to progress in their level of qualifications.

Level 2 Diploma in Care (RQF)



The Level 2 Diploma in Care is the equivalent to, as some refer as the NVQ level 2 in Health and Social Care. It covers the mandatory units as recognised by the Awarding Bodies,

Skills for Care and CQC and the optional units can be discussed with managers and learners although it is worth noting that some of the short courses can be used as part of their optional units. It is primarily aimed at those fairly new to the Care sector and is often the preferred choice to the Care Certificate as the Diplomas are accredited through external bodies whereas the Care Certificate is not.

Level 5 Diploma in Leadership and Management for Adult Care (RQF)



The Level 5 Diploma again is aimed at current managers and those aspiring to be one that may have responsibilities that a manager may hold within a care setting as some of

the units will require this such as managing finances and hosting team meetings. This is the qualification that CQC look for when Deputy Managers aspire to become a Manager.
