

A HISTORY WORTH MENTIONING

In 1919, two ambitious mid-age sisters moved from the Midwest to Lake Arrowhead to build their dream castle. This resulted in the Raven, a twenty-eight room three-story English Tavern that played host to the Southland's elite for thirty-four years. Over the past ninety-six years, many famous people have frequented this historic Inn. Howard Hughes was a visitor, along with the Charles Lindberghs, plus the exciting Hollywood and entertainment communities.

The Raven passed down through family until 1953 when a local realtor purchased the hotel and several adjacent cottages. The Arrowhead Inn and Cottages continued to provide popular lodging for another thirty years. In 1983, the "Inn" was sold...at which time the Saddleback Inn - Arrowhead was born.

King or Queen bedrooms are located in the Main Inn or in the four-plex located outside the Inn. All with double whirlpool bathtubs, mini refrigerators, television and gas log fireplaces.

Room numbers 11-20 and 29-32

One Bedroom Cottages all have the double whirlpool bathtubs, mini refrigerators, television and most have a gas log fireplace. All with King or Queen size bed.

Room numbers 22-24, 26, 34-36

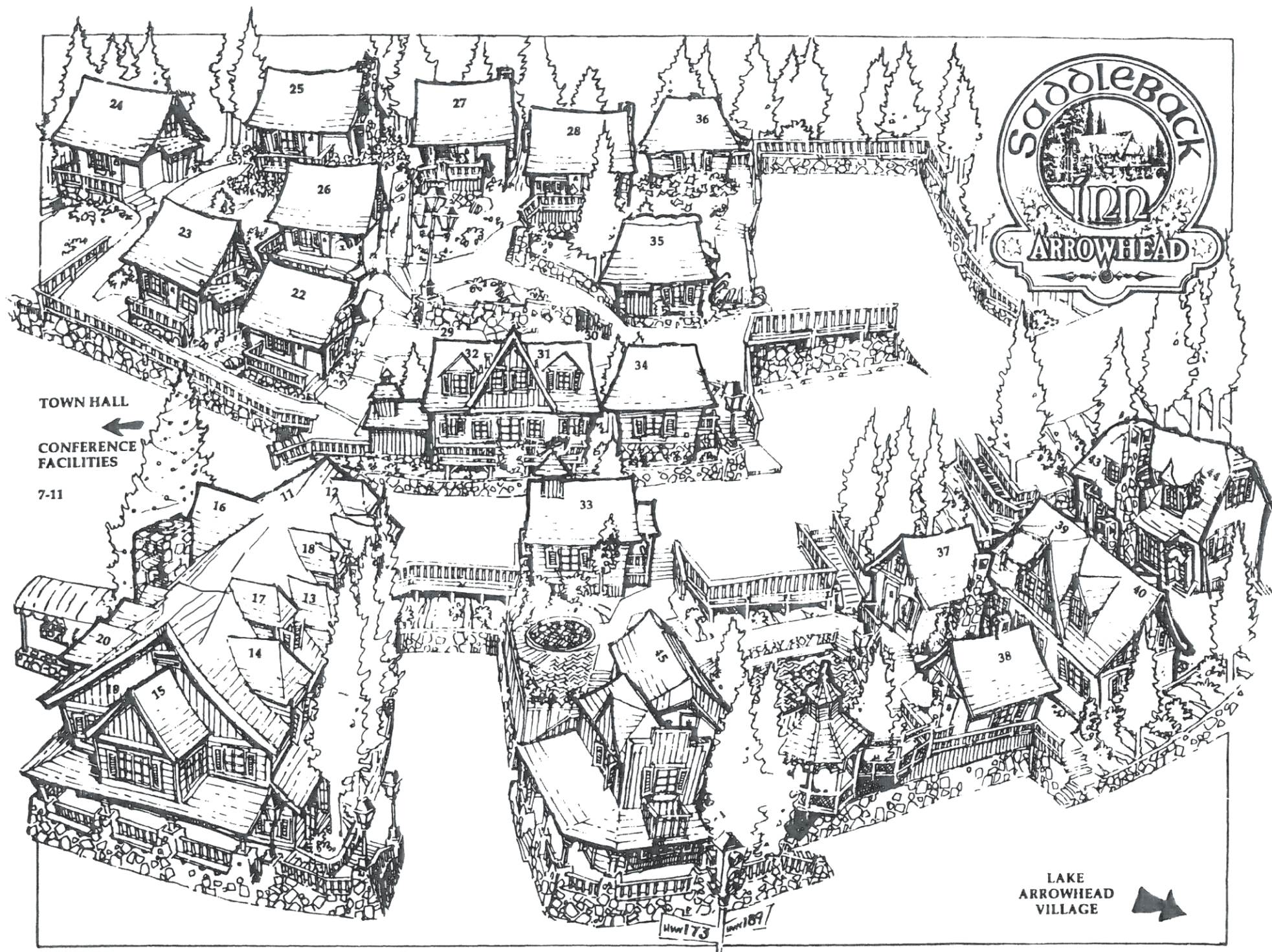
One Bedroom Suites all have a double whirlpool bathtub, gas log fireplace, television and mini refrigerator. All with living rooms with sleeper sofa or queen airbed, and King bed in the bedroom. Suites are available in one or two stories. Two story suites have an additional half-bathroom.

Room numbers 27, 28, 37, 38, 39, 43, 44

Two and Three Bedroom Suites are two stories. All have a double whirlpool bathtub, mini refrigerator, television and gas log fireplace. All suites have a living room with sofa and separate bedrooms with a variety of bed sizes.

Rooms 25, 33 and 40 are our large multi-bedroom suites with a living room.

Cottage 45 has two Double beds, freestanding shower, television and mini refrigerator.
