XF-60 Dark Yellow
XF-10 Flat Brown

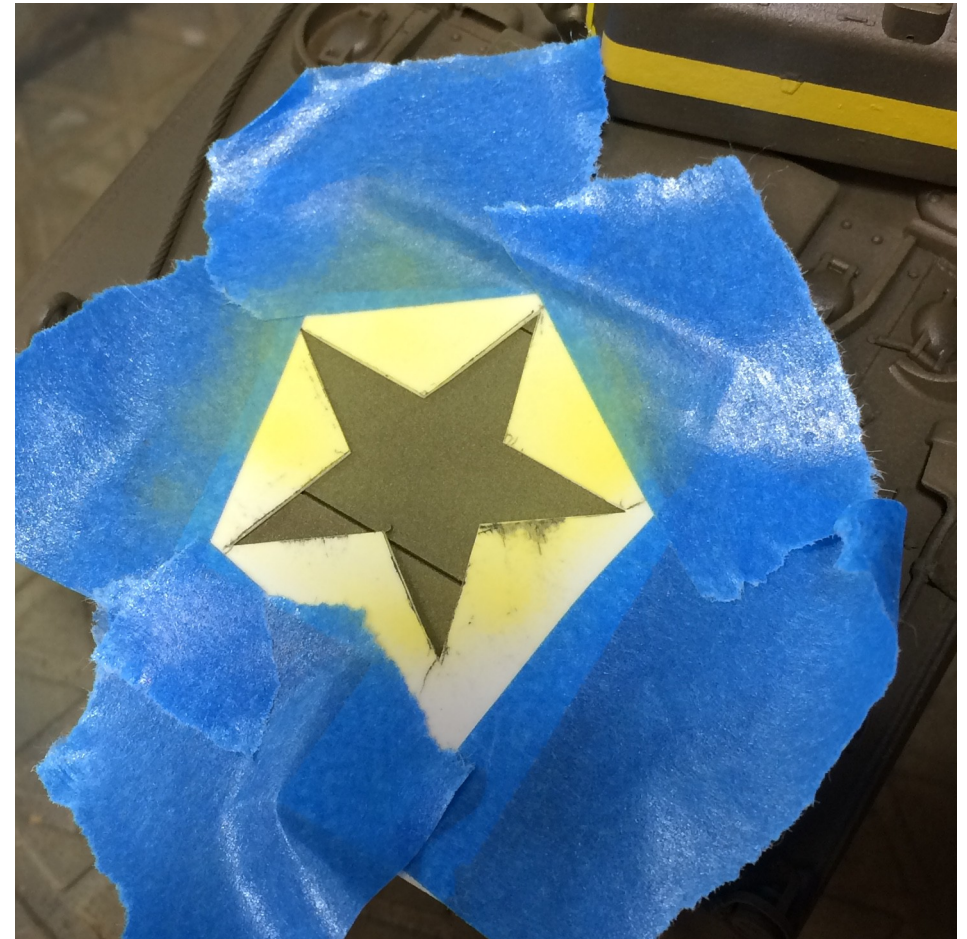

Part VI

- Next step was to paint the yellow band around the turret. This was masked off using Tamiya tape, and then sprayed. XF-3 Flat Yellow with a bit of XF-57 Buff to dull down the yellow. The Star mask was cut out of .010 sheet plastic using an old decal as a master, and then taped to the engine deck.

- Decal time. Decals are from Bison Decals. Note the 'fuzziness' of the rear star.

- Beginning of weathering, using AK Interactive Kursk Earth, and Dust Effects as washes.

- More weathering... this time with some pigment mixed with mineral spirits from home depot
- Trying to get very heavy cover of dust, especially lower to ground.
- Went back and dry brushed with a dark olive drab color, mostly along top of hull, and to give areas where dust would have been worn away from use by the crew.
