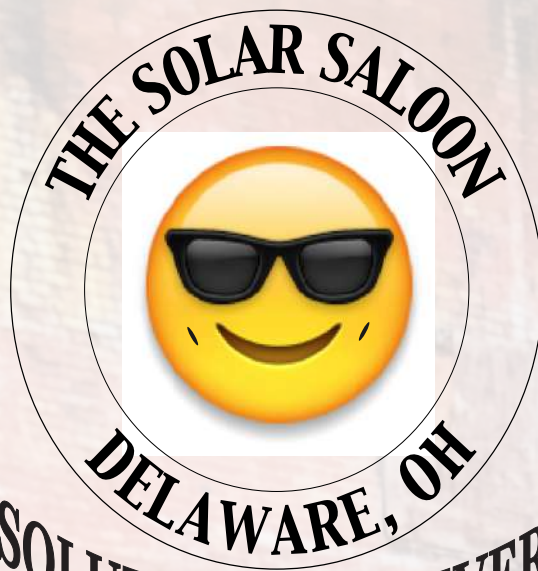

Build a Planter Box With Only 2 Tools

Looking for an easy weekend project?

Check out this simple planter box that you can make with just a miter saw and a finishing nail gun! This is a great project for anyone new to power tools and looks beautiful on your front porch.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED.

(5) 1x4x8 pieces of treated lumber
(3) 2x2x8 pieces of treated lumber
30" of 1x2 scrap lumber
wood glue
measuring tape
miter saw
finishing nail gun
2" brad nails

MAKING THE PLANTER

Next, lay (5) 16" 1x4s together with their long sides butted up against each other. Place one 16" 2x2 on top of the 1x4s on each side as shown above. Nail those in place with a brad nailer (finishing nail gun) and 2" brad nails. I'm putting about 9 nails on each side. Repeat to create two sides of the planter.

Now, lay 5 more 16" 1x4s together and rest one of the finished side panels on top, butting it up to the edge. Nail in place. Repeat by adding the other finished side panel to the other side.

Now, add the 20" 2x2 leg pieces to each outside corner of the planter with wood glue and brad nails, ensuring the top edge is flush with the planter.

CUT LIST

(20) 1x4 at 16" long
(4) 1x4 at 15" long (short side measurement) with 45 degree angled ends
(4) 2x2 at 20" long
(4) 2x2 at 16" long
(2) 2x2 at 12" long
(3) scrap wood at 15" long (for interior brace)

Next, create a platform inside the planter a few inches from the bottom by nailing the 12" 2x2s to two sides inside the planter and nailing the 3 scrap wood pieces evenly spaced on top.

Finish the planter by attaching the 4 angled 15" long 1x4s to the top of the planter with brad nails. I find it works best to put these in place first, and ensure they're lined up nicely on top of the planter. Then, nail the corners of the trim to the planter first, and put a final nail through the corners horizontally to hold them together.

You can strengthen the planter by adding more nails to the ends of the 1x4s from the outside.

Civics

In the 2020 presidential election, the popular vote in Delaware County, OH went to Donald J. Trump with 52.6% of the vote. The runner-up was Joseph R Biden Jr. (45.8%), followed by Jo Jorgensen (1.29%).

Housing & Living

People in Delaware County, OH have an average commute time of 26.1 minutes, and they drove alone to work. Car ownership in Delaware County, OH is approximately the same as the national average, with an average of 2 cars per household.

Education

In 2021, universities in Delaware County, OH

awarded 3,252 degrees. The student population of Delaware County, OH in 2021 is skewed towards men, with 5,200 male students and 2,524 female students.

The largest universities in Delaware County, OH by number of degrees awarded are MyComputerCareer.edu-Columbus (2,839 and 87.3%), Ohio Wesleyan University (374 and 11.5%), and Methodist Theological School in Ohio (39 and 1.2%).

Instant Pot Applesauce

Did you know that not all applesauce is created equal? That's the truth. Any time I'm forced to buy store-bought applesauce it's a struggle. It's like buying store-bought jam. Every single brand and type has so much sugar, and most of them don't even taste very good. Am I sounding like a total applesauce snob? I'm sorry, but homemade applesauce is just so easy and so GOOD, especially if you have an instant pot. The first time I made applesauce in the instant pot I was blown away. That machine just continues to amaze me! (I have this 6qt instant pot). It was so incredibly easy and turned out perfect, with very little time or effort on my part.

How to make applesauce in the instant pot:

First, you choose your apples. I like a blend of sweet and tart apples to make really great flavor for the applesauce, without having to

add extra sweetener. Granny Smith and Honey Crisp combination is definitely my favorite. Peel, core and slice the apples. I use a johnny apple peeler to peel, core and slice the apples super quickly. Add your apples to the instant pot. Toss the apples in water, cinnamon and lemon juice, and cook them on manual or high pressure for 8 minutes. After a controlled quick release, open up the lid and the apples have literally turned to applesauce! You don't need to do anything but give them a little stir. The taste is AMAZING—perfectly sweet, especially with a little extra cinnamon on top. If you used different apples, and feel that it needs to be sweeter, you could add some white or brown sugar. I love applesauce that I can feel good about feeding my kids. I know exactly what's in it, and everyone LOVES it! It's its own type of delicious comfort food, don't you think?

INGREDIENTS

4 large Granny Smith apples , peeled, cored and roughly chopped

4 large Honeycrisp apples , peeled, cored and roughly chopped

1 cup water

1 Tablespoon fresh lemon juice

1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon

DIRECTIONS

- 1 Peel and core apples. I use a johnny apple peeler to do all three steps at once (peel, slice and core).
- 2 Add water, lemon juice and cinnamon to instant pot and stir to combine. Add apples and toss to mix.
- 3 Secure lid and cook on manual (high pressure) for 8 minutes. Do a controlled quick release or allow the pressure to naturally release.
- 4 Mash the apple mixture a few times with a potato masher, if desired. (If you like a smoother texture you could pulse it in the blender.)
- 5 Transfer contents to a bowl and allow to cool completely. Stir in more cinnamon, if desired, to taste. Enjoy warm or cold. Store in the fridge for up to 7-10 days.
