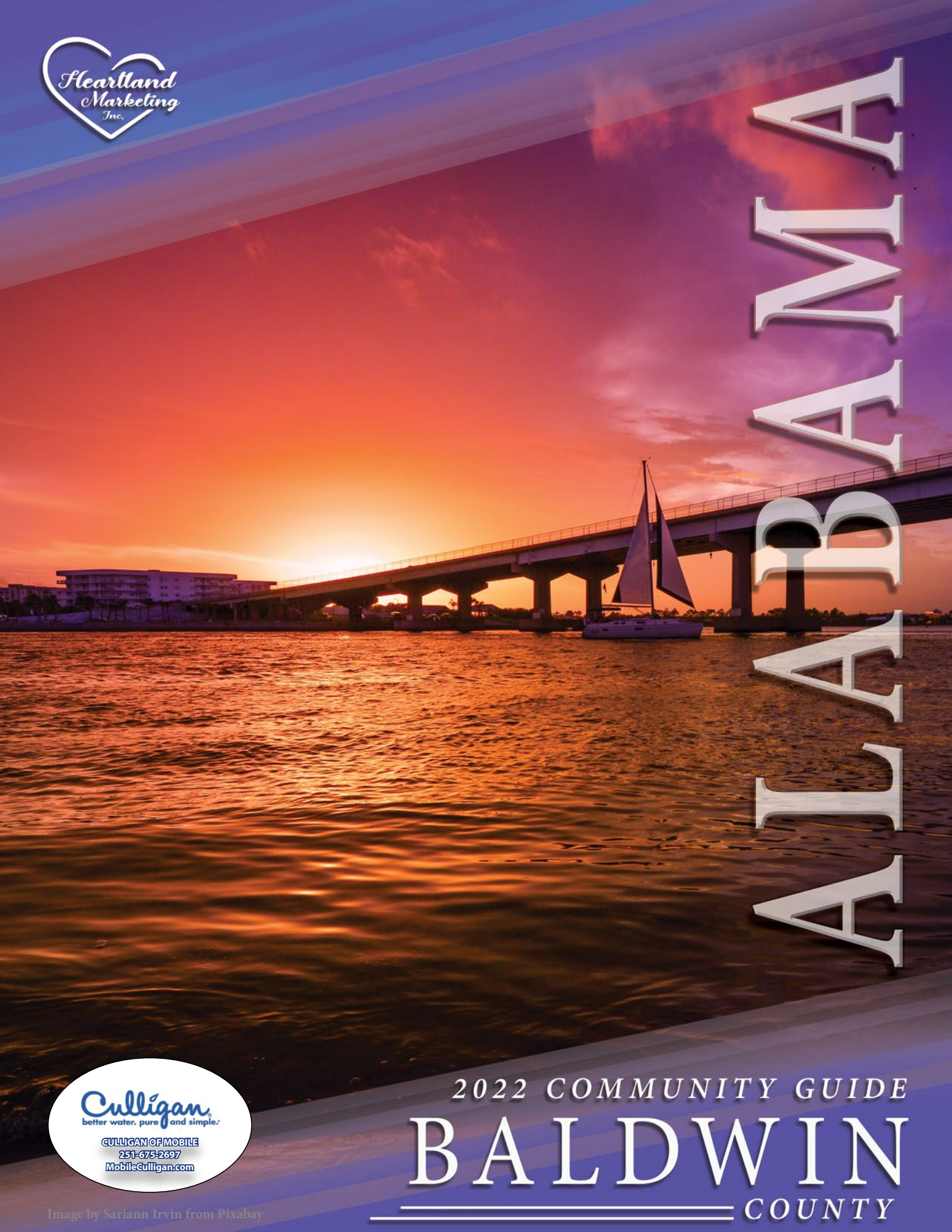

**BALDWIN CO, AL** is situated along the shores of the Gulf of Mexico and Mobile Bay.

As indicated by the 2019 U.S. Statistics, the number of inhabitants in Baldwin County was formally recorded at 223,234 occupants. While the county has fourteen joined districts, extending in size, a dominant part of Baldwin's populace lives in the country, unincorporated zones.

The county seat is located in the City of Bay Minette and is represented by a four part area commission.

It is named in honor of Senator Abraham Baldwin, though he never lived in what is now Alabama.

Baldwin County was established on December 21, 1809, ten years before Alabama became a state.

Previously, the county had been a part of the Mississippi Territory until 1817, when the area was included in the separate Alabama Territory. Statehood was gained by Alabama in 1819.

Today, out of Alabama's sixty-seven counties, Baldwin County stays one of the quickest developing in the state.

Baldwin County remains a mainstream destinations for guests, from everywhere throughout the country and world, all year as a result of top of the line greens, excellent shorelines, boundless recreational experiences, wellbeing economy and top of the line government funded educational system.

Two separate areas in Baldwin County have been designated as "Outstanding Alabama Water" by the Alabama Environmental Management Commission. The Baldwin County Commission has also been awarded the South Alabama Regional Planning Commission's (SARPC) Award, Alabama Governments Award in the Digital Government Innovation and recipient of the Excellence in County Government Urban County Category award from the ACCA.

**W**elcome!! Daphne is a family-oriented community with wonderful views and rich in history. Situated in the core of the Eastern Shore, the “Jubilee City” has developed from the city’s incorporation in 1927 to the biggest city in Baldwin County today. Daphne is known as a Community of Opportunity. The success can be attributed to a strong sense of community, which is the culmination of heritage, southern charm, recreational opportunities, and economic success combined with our most valuable asset – the hospitality and beauty of Daphne.

On the off chance that you are considering moving to Daphne or have as of late moved to the “Celebration City”, you will find that it’s a “city on the move.” Even with steady development, Daphne has had the capacity to keep up the mood of a community where the general population are inviting and minding, and newcomers turned out to be great friends!

Regardless of whether you’re visiting us from far away, a newcomer to the territory, or an inhabitant of many years, Daphne welcomes you! Experience the parks and

trails, visit notable milestones, encounter Olde Towne Daphne, and make the most of the nearby eateries and retailers. There are such a large number of opportunities to make the most of Daphne and to see why it’s such a unique area to live, work and play!

The inhabited history of what is now called Daphne dates at least to the Paleo-Indian period and Native American tribes around 9000 BC. Modern-day Daphne is a thriving suburb of nearby Mobile. Daphne has adopted the nickname “The Jubilee City” in recognition of its status as one of the locations of

the Mobile Bay jubilee. The only other place jubilees occur is in Tokyo Bay.

Records indicate April 9, 1874 as the actual establishment of the town to be called Daphne with the designation of a Postmaster and official Post Office for the Community. Daphne was a resort area prior to the War between the States.



Daphne was incorporated on July 8, 1927 with a population of only 500. Originally, Daphne was the Baldwin County seat of government. However, Daphne’s courthouse records were stolen one night by the rival community of Bay Minette, where the Baldwin County seat of government remains today.

Located on the eastern shoreline of Mobile Bay, the city is located along I-10, 11 miles east of Mobile and 170 miles southwest of the state capital of Montgomery. The 2019 United States Census lists the population of the city as 25,901, making Daphne the most populous city in Baldwin County. It is a principal city of the Daphne-Fairhope-Foley metropolitan area, which includes all of Baldwin County.

Bayfront Park is a popular park that sits right on the Mobile Bay. Walk on the beach, watch sailboats drift by, watch the sunset, or drop a fishing line. A boardwalk



connects to the Village Point Park Preserve. There’s a beautiful gazebo under the trees with seating and a great view of the water along with a pier, kayak and canoe access. A pavilion sits on the property that is available for rent; it has over 7,000 square feet of space and can accommodate from 20 to 299 people.

Summers in Daphne are hot and muggy. The “hot” season lasts from mid-May through September, with an average daily high above 84 degrees. The “cool” season lasts from December through February, with an average daily high below 66 degrees. Temperature in Daphne typically varies from 42 degrees to 89 degrees and is rarely below 28 degrees or above 94 degrees.

The Daphne-Fairhope-Foley metropolitan area is listed in Forbes 2017 Rankings as #16 out of 200 Best Small Places for Business and Careers. Forbes forecasts “the job growth rate in this metro is expected to be one of the fastest in the country over the next three years.” Currently, the job growth rate is at 3.5%.

Daphne has the ambiance of a small town with friendly and caring people. It offers an interesting mix of suburban, rural, and waterfront environments located on the eastern side of the Mobile Bay.

Fairhope lies on a sloping plateau, along the cliffs and shoreline of Mobile Bay. It is located 6 miles south of Daphne and 10 miles south of Spanish Fort. The 20107 census lists the population of the city as 20,935. Fairhope is a principal city of the Daphne-Fairhope-Foley micropolitan area, which includes all of Baldwin County. In 2016, Fairhope was named the best small town in the South by Southern Living magazine.

It has always been a resort community, early visitors came by Bayboat from Mobile to vacation in the small bay cottages and hotels along the bluff top. Vacationers came to Fairhope in the early days for many of the same reasons they do today: its pleasant climate, peaceful surroundings, and inspiring scenery.

Fairhope has a humid subtropical climate. It experiences hot, humid summers and generally mild winters, with average temperatures ranging from 81.9 °F (27.7 °C) in the summer to 50.4 °F (10.2 °C) during winter.

Over the years artists, writers, and craftsmen have found Fairhope to be an inspiring haven for their work and have helped to make the community what it is today.

Fairhope was founded in November 1894 on the site of the former Alabama City as a radical Georgist “Single-Tax” colony by the Fairhope Industrial Association, a group of 28 followers of economist Henry George who had incorporated earlier that year in Des Moines, Iowa.

The city founders settled on the high bluff where they bought clear-cut wasteland for \$5.50 per acre. They thought using the Single Tax plan would give them at least a “fair hope” of succeeding. Thus, the Fairhope Single Tax Colony was founded, attracting supporters and

financial backers from around the country and drawing an eclectic assemblage of industrious, creative and free-thinking people to Fairhope, Alabama.

For over 50 years, fishermen and residents of Fairhope have experienced the “jubilee” phenomenon. During a jubilee along the shores of Mobile Bay, some aquatic

animals, including blue crabs, flounder, stingrays, and eels, come to the shallow water. At those times, it is possible to catch the fish, crabs, and other sea life near the water’s edge.



The Weeks Bay Nature Reserve, located 10 miles to the southeast, is known for the many oaks, wildlife and pitcher plants along the elevated walkways through the swamp forest.

The Bell Building on the Faulkner State Community College campus houses the Marietta Johnson Museum. The Fairhope Museum of History is located downtown.

Fairhope is a biking town, with trails that wind along the coast and through some beautiful historic neighborhoods. Bring your own, rent them in town.

Make sure to visit the Grand Hotel Marriott Resort, Golf Club, & Spa. Built in 1847, it served as a Confederate hospital during the Civil War, and the hotel’s military past is still honored every day with a ceremonial canon firing at 4:00 pm. The sunsets are unmatched, and you can watch them from a brick path that surrounds the property or a long fishing pier that shoots out into Mobile Bay.

With its appealing pedestrian-friendly shopping district with lots of character, there is good reasons to visit Fairhope, Alabama, especially in the off-season. If you love the Gulf Coast, there are few places more scenic, with antebellum homes, streets lined with live oaks, and a charming, walkable downtown.

## 5 Essential Car Safety Tips For Pets

(BPT) - Face it, everyone loves their pets. And they often want to take their pets wherever they're going. In fact, a recent survey by Volvo Car USA and The Harris Poll found that 39% of pet owners would rather go on a road trip with their dog than a family member.

However, many pet owners worry about pet safety in a vehicle. Seventy-seven percent of respondents said that people don't take vehicular pet safety seriously. Furthermore, nearly a third of dog owners reported leaving their furry friend home due to concerns about road safety.

These concerns aren't unwarranted. The survey also examined driver behavior when pets were unrestrained in a vehicle and discovered eye-opening results.

The amount of unsafe driving behaviors more than doubled when dogs were unrestrained in a car compared to when they were restrained in a harness or cage. Allowing dogs to roam free led to frantic movements that distracted the driver, and dogs' heart rates spiked 7 beats per minute faster while riding unrestrained.

What can you do to keep your pet safer while driving? Dr. Elisa Mazzaferro, a veter-

inary specialist at Cornell University, shares some common but unsafe practices that pet owners should avoid.

### 1. Don't drive with your pet in the front seat

In the event of a collision, your pet can be thrown into the windshield, even if restrained. Unless the passenger side airbag is disengaged, airbag deployment alone can be very dangerous to a small pet.

### 2. Never drive with a pet on your lap

In addition to distracting the driver, a pet can get caught under the steering wheel and cause an accident or projected forward into the windshield in the event of a collision. Additionally, the pet is positioned between the airbag and the driver, which is dangerous to both the driver and the pet.

### 3. Never drive with an unrestrained pet in the vehicle

Beyond the animal being a serious distraction, an abrupt stop can cause a pet to fall quickly, causing soft tissue injury or worse. In the event of an accident, a pet could jump from the vehicle and run into moving traffic.

### 4. Never allow your pet to lean out of a car window

While it may look like dogs are enjoying the rush of the wind in their fur, debris can be

forced into their eyes and cause abrasions or punctures to their cornea, which could result in serious injury or blindness.

### 5. Never leave a dog unattended in a vehicle
