On August 18, 1965, a small group of Charter Members attended the first official meeting of the Springs Fire Department at Ashawagh Hall. This meeting followed a lengthy process to create the Springs Fire District, affording the residents of Springs a more localized response to their calls for assistance. The founding of the Springs Fire Department is a testament to what is possible when a cause is good and necessary and the people committed to that cause are open to both the opportunities and the challenges that will arise.

And challenges there were plenty! A small budget, no facility and virtually no equipment. The first of our fire apparatus and equipment was acquired from other Fire Departments by donation or reduced-price sales. Those Charter Members worked hard to build the core of our Department and to navigate a course toward the future.

Over the years those initial challenges were met, but changing times brings new ones. Today, living in Springs is as special a place as it's ever been and we all know how lucky we are. Volunteering to help our neighbors takes a special breed. I am incredibly appreciative of all who accept the challenge, and who reap the rewards of answering the call when tones go off in the middle of the work day or in the middle of the night.

As we approach 2025, we reflect on all the volunteers that have served in the Springs Fire Department over these 60 years. We are also very proud of the many new members who have joined our ranks, working and training hard to respond to your calls for assistance. Through October of 2024 the Department responded to 418 ambulance calls and 64 fire calls, inclusive of ongoing mutual aid to surrounding districts when called upon to do so.
