WATER/WASTEWATER

- Installed new injector at tower.
- Did monthly meter reads.
- Repaired water leak on Second Street.
- Flushed and jetted sewer multiple times on First Street.

CITY VEHICLE/BUILDING MAINTENANCE/REPAIR/PURCHASES

- Painted 10' John Deer mower, installed another rubber belt guard on the front.

- Worked on sprayers; installed another pump on the 50-gallon sprayer.

MOWING/SPRAYING/TREES & LIMBS
