## TOWN MANAGER REPORT for February 8, 2022, through March 5, 2022

### WATER/WASTEWATER

- Collaborated with engineer on water project. She has requested more items/maps for CDGB grant application. I asked Lynda for the remaining reports.
- Prepared water system and wells for cold weather.
- Repaired one (1) leak on Third.
- Dug on Seventh St. to try to find 8" PVC water main (per map). Not found.
- Cleared blockage on sewer on Fastrunner.
- Installed cleanout on sewer on Fastrunner so we can jet the main.
- Did dirt work to help with the existing manhole.

### CITY VEHICLE/BUILDING MAINTENANCE/REPAIR/PURCHASES

- Obtained two bids to purchase two new mowers (John Deere and SKAG).
- Rebuilt carburetor on jetter.
- Worked on meter pump.
- Washed Kubota and John Deere backhoe and mower.
- Vermeer made an offer to purchase the mulcher.
- Painted John Deere mower.
- Cleaned and waxed floors in Town Hall.

### MOWING/SPRAYING/TREES & LIMBS

- Trimmed trees on Third, First, Tawakonie, Fourth, and Ponjo.
- Trimmed trees in alley between Hazlett and Third
- Picked up limbs from curbs left by residents.

### STREETS & DRAINAGE

- Scheduled "walk-thru" meeting with ODOT for March 16 at 10:00 am
- Cleaned Hazlett (Highway 9) from Fastrunner to Ponjo
- Cleaned out (dug out) ditches on north end of town which hopefully tin horns will open up if we get a good rain. If not, we will jet them.
- Cleaned Main Street, First Street, and two blocks on Ponjo.
- Hauled away more dirt for East Street drainage.
- Removed curb on Third and Fastrunner to help with drainage.
- Pushed ice off south side of Main Street, also some on Fastrunner.
- Speed bump signs are built and ready to install.

### STRAYS/ANIMAL CONTROL

- Relocated dog houses on dog pens to outside of pen, easier to clean and more room for animals and hung water/feeders on pens so animals would have more room.

- Picked up two (2) dogs.
- One (1) warning was issued.

#### **WASTE/TRASH/TOWN CLEANUP**

- The Town is losing \$1.53 on each second poly cart. Please consider increasing the cost.

#### **COMMUNITY BUILDING/SENIOR NUTRITION**
