Meeting was called to order at 1:00 p.m.

<u>Present:</u> Carol Lee Anderson, Ruth Christopherson, Laurel Gardey, Joan Jaguszewski, Ann Jordan, Chris McManamon, Kitte Rach, Marilyn Stuart and Mary Gray.

<u>Minutes</u>: Mary read the June 6, 2019 Minutes. Laurel motioned to approve; Joan second; approved. Treasurer's Report:

WELCA's checking account beginning balance May 19, 2019 \$1,700.32
One deposit from the June 6, 2019 WELCA Meeting \$19.00
WELCA checking account ending balance June 19, 2019 \$1,719.32

Joan reimbursed Laurel \$45 for the carnations/greens for the funeral lunch. Laurel also gave Joan \$5.25 for WELCA.

Messiah received the Registration form for Christmas In the Village. There is a \$25 application fee, and a \$5 fee per table. Joan will fill out and send in the Registration form, along with a check for \$40 to reserve Messiah's spot (\$35 Registration and \$5 for one table).

WELCA has not yet received the \$500 "Direct Your Dollars" from Family Fare;

Ann stated that it could take about three months. (Just a reminder — Messiah and St. Elizabeth's collected and combined receipts. The Direct Your Dollars \$1,000 amount was submitted by Messiah and is being split between Messiah and St. Elizabeth's. NOTE: Messiah and St. Elizabeth's can continue to collect 'Direct Your Dollars' receipts; the next submission will go under St. Elizabeth's name, and the \$1,000 Direct Your Dollars amount will be split between St. Elizabeth and Messiah. (Ann will have a grocery bag in Messiah's Fellowship Hall for receipts.)

### Memorial Service/Funeral Luncheon for Ernie Stuart

The Memorial Service/Funeral Luncheon for Ernie Stuart on Friday, June 28, went very well. We had over 100 Family, Friends and Messiah members in attendance. Marilyn wanted to say, "Thank You for everything Messiah did for me and my family. You made a sad occasion turn into a good occasion. Everyone in my family said this as well".

Future Funeral/Memorial Service and/or Luncheons

In the future, if there is a need for Messiah to have a Funeral/Memorial Service and/or Luncheon (especially when WELCA is not meeting to discuss). WELCA will have a

contact person from Messiah who will call members to help with food for a luncheon, etc. Carol Lee Anderson volunteered to take on this assignment.

NOTE: I prepared a sheet based on the number of people attending a funeral luncheon that I will e-mail separately when I send out these Minutes. Another need would be Messiah Ushers to seat friends and family. We can discuss again at our August WELCA meeting.

Replace Messiah Candle Caps, Offering Plates

Chris McManamon did not think WELCA needed to replace the candle caps because Messiah does have another set. WELCA thought our offering plates (12-1/2"x3") should be replaced. Ann researched and found brass-toned offering plates @ \$69.95/each. Cory will order 2 offering plates, have the company ship and invoice Messiah, and WELCA will pay the invoice.

Replace our Food Pantry "basket" with a real basket.

Ann researched and found several baskets; decision was not made at this meeting.

Requests for Funds

WELCA received a couple of donation requests:

Habitat for Humanity: Laurel motioned that WELCA contribute \$50 to Habitat, Ann second, approved.

(Note: apparently Habitat is not building new homes at this time,

but is refurbishing older homes.)

Artesia Youth Park (Loxley Road, Houghton Lake) is hosting a Men's Golf Outing;

WELCA has posted information on the Messiah bulletin board if MELCA is interested.

Christmas in the Village - Pie Making

WELCA discussed making pie crusts in advance for Christmas in the Village. Laurel will check the pie crusts she has frozen; maybe we can start in the Fall.

We will also ask Judy Legg if she will check at our Roscommon Farmer's Market for apples (before the Market closes in the Fall—we were too late last year).

Laurel will be placing a RADA order, please let her know on Sunday, July 14 (per an e-mail from Cory). (WELCA is ordering 2 more small spatulas for our desserts.)
