Messiah Lutheran Church Council Minutes - August 19, 2019

President Joan Jaguszewski called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Pastor Lonnie Wilkerson opened with a prayer.

Roll Call: Present: Joan Jaguszewski, Terry Sanders, Lacey Wilkerson, Rick Falardeau, Mike Raymond, Dianne Sanders, Pastor Lonnie Wilkerson, Harold Kramm, LaDonna Kramm, AJ Newkirk, Ron Anderson, Carol Lee Anderson. Absent: Marilyn Stuart.

Guests: Samantha Maun, Jan Wilkerson, and Chris McManaman.

Agenda: Motion by Carol Lee Anderson, second by Mike Raymond to approve the agenda as presented. Motion passed.

Approval of Minutes: Motion by LaDonna Kramm, second by Dianne Sanders to approve the minutes as presented. Motion passed.

Pastor's Report: There were nine people at the service at the Brook. Pastor had 3 visits, made 10 calls and a special service, "Blessing of the Bikes" during the month. The new Bible study starts on September 3rd with "Daniel – A Life Changing Encounter with God's Word. Pastor will be gone September 15 and 16. We need someone to preside over the service on the 16th. There will be no bible study on November 26th. The Advent Bible study begins December 3rd through the 17th.

Pastor Lonnie has requested to purchase 20 giant print NIV bibles, \$25 per bible, for a total of \$500. Motion to purchase 20 giant print bibles at a cost of \$25 per bible motioned by Lacey Wilkerson, second by Dianne Sanders. Motion passed.

As we change from a calendar year budget to a fiscal year budget, we need to have the Annual Meeting on November 17th to present the six-month budget (January to June 2020).

Pastor Lonnie will need pulpit coverage for September 15th. December 1st is the Chrismon Service by Ann Jordan, so there will be no sermon.

Membership: Per Section C8.05 Removal from Membership Resignation of Barb Ernest from membership – a letter will be sent to her about the Council's acceptance of her membership removal. Ron Anderson will provide an updated membership list for next council meeting.

Treasurer's Report: Terry Sanders mentioned that Shay's Play Place rent should say \$500 but is only showing \$400. The extra hundred dollars should be showing up in the financial reports. Motion to accept the treasurer's report by Harold Kramm, second by Mike Raymond. Motion passed. Committee Reports: Mutual Ministry: nothing to report Stewardship: stewardship letters printed and ready for distribution Outreach – nothing to report Property Management: nothing to report Education: nothing to report Worship Life: nothing to report

Publicity: nothing to report Community Dinners: nothing to report WELCA: minutes attached MELCA: nothing to report Children's Church: nothing to report

Correspondence: 1. Letter from Ann Jordan resigning from SOS – will be added to the announcements that we're looking for people to learn SOS: Council accepted her resignation from SOS. 2. Letter from Barb Ernest removing her membership from Messiah Lutheran: Council accepted her resignation from membership.

Old Business: 1. Church Steeple – Painting is completed; waiting on the roofer to be available to install the metal portion to the steeple. 2. Door Locks – Still waiting on a quote. 3. Investment for some church funds – tabled until October meeting.

New Business: 1. Possible Fundraiser – "Church Life, Family Style" t-shirts: tabled 2. Waste Management/Republic Garbage pickup – tabled 3. Utility Bills: Dianne Sanders and Lacey Wilkerson calculated the annual utility cost for the church and divided it between the church and Shay's Play Place. Based on the square footage of the building use, Shay's Play Place makes up 28% of the annual utility cost. Based on this information, it was advised to save this for a later time for discussion, as the Council should make it as fair as possible for both the church and Shay's Play Place. Pastor Lonnie asked the Council to call the Grayling AuSable Daycare about their rent amount and square footage for comparison. 4. Funeral Plant Arrangement Fund/Policy: discussion followed with the process for purchasing a live plant for any active member who passes.

Item for Next Meeting: 1. Updated Membership list from Ron Anderson

Next meeting will be September 16, 2019 at 7:00 pm.

Motion to adjourn by Carol Lee Anderson, second by LaDonna Kramm. Motion passed. Council adjourned with the Lord's Prayer at 8:12 pm.

<u>Minutes</u>: Mary read the August 1, 2019 Minutes. Carol Lee motioned to approve; Marilyn second; approved.

Treasurer's Report:

WELCA's checking account beginning balance July 19, 2019 \$ 1,000.59*

*Note: The Family Fare "Direct Your Dollars" check (which was made out to Messiah), was given to Jim Heinlein. Jim, in turn, made out a check to WELCA in the amount of \$1,000. The \$1,000 check was deposited to WELCA's account, however, will not show up until the August statement is received from Chase Bank. Our WELCA checking balance will then show \$2,000.59.

<u>Just a reminder</u>: Messiah and St. Elizabeth's can continue to collect 'Direct Your Dollars' receipts; the next submission will go under St. Elizabeth's name, and the \$1,000 Direct Your Dollars amount will be split between St. Elizabeth and Messiah. (Please place your Family Fare receipts in Ann Jordan's mailbox.)

Several Discussion Items were Tabled until today's Meeting:

Replace our Food Pantry "basket" with a real basket: Chris McManamon will be looking for a basket at St. Vincent's that might fit our needs.

<u>Pie Making details for Christmas in the Village</u>: Judy Legg stated that she had been at the Roscommon Farm Market a couple of times but did not see the "apple lady"; Judy will keep checking. Yes, pie slices went well. We have enough supplies, and we will discuss further at our October meeting.

<u>RADA (WELCA fundraising) order:</u> Laurel stated that WELCA made \$61.50 in profits, minus \$8.00 (2 spatulas for Messiah's kitchen). So, the RADA fundraising profit was \$53.50; Laurel gave a check in that amount to Joan J. for deposit.

Additional Travel Communion Kits (R. Anderson requested 3 new kits)

WELCA discussed our communion kits. Ruth C. motioned that WELCA approve the purchase of 3 new travel communion kits, Judy L. second, approved. WELCA will ask Cory to order from the new Concordia Supply catalog, Item A, \$34.95/ea. Cory will have the supplier invoice Messiah and WELCA will pay the invoice.

Messiah's present communion kits were also discussed — keeping wafers fresh, no cups or dirty cups (please throw away disposable cups prior to placing them back in the kits), etc. There is a "check-in" sheet that should be filled out when taking/returning communion kits. And, the kits should be returned before the end of each month so that everything may be Blessed at the beginning of each month.

Child Assessment Center

Ann Jordan has a "wish list" from the Child Assessment Center. WELCA discussed. Joan J. will ask Margaret Karinen to request a Thrivent Action Team Card. Several ladies can then shop for items on the list and deliver to the Child Assessment Center. Jan or Ed Pearen could answer. any questions.

Roscommon County Animal Shelter

Cory applied for a Thrivent Action Team card to provide food for the Shelter. Joan J. did the shopping, and WELCA helped after today's meeting by putting Thrivent Card stickers on every dog food bag, transferring the items to Chris McManamon and Kitty Rach's vehicles, then delivering the food to the Shelter. Pictures were taken and Cory forwarded them to the Community.
