Agenda: Motion by Carol Lee Anderson 2nd by Lacy Wilkerson to approve the agenda as presented. Motion approved. **Approval of Minutes:** Motion by Marilyn Stuart, 2nd by Ric Falardeau to approve the minutes as presented. Motion

approved. **Pastor's Report:** There were 9 people at the service at the Brook. Pastor had 5 visits, 2 vow renewals, 1 wedding, 2 funerals, and 1 child baptism during the month. The new Bible study starts on July 9. Pastor will be gone September 15 and 16. We need someone to preside over the service on the 16th. Pastor is considering 3 Bible studies – (1) The Gospel According to Leviticus, (2) Romans – What Jesus' Life, Death and Resurrection Mean or (3) Daniel – How God's Perspective Can Give Us New Vision.

Treasurer's Report: Jim Heinlein reviewed the treasurer reports. Motion by L. Wilkerson, 2nd by M. Stuart to accept the report. Motion approved. The secretary will e-mail any invoices received to J. Heinlein. Motion by L. Kramm, 2nd by C. Anderson to move the balance of Earmarked Flowers of \$5.12 to Snow Removal/Lawn Care. Motion approved. The Contract for Shay's Play Place runs through 2021. We need to look into the utility bills and compare usage during the time the play school is in session. Money is in a dedicated fund for a plant to be presented to a member who has passed away. Diane Sanders and Lacey Wilkerson will look into a procedure for doing this. Motion by T. Sanders, 2nd by AJ Newkirk that Calendar Funds of \$799.15 will be transferred to Publicity and be used to promote the church. Motion approved. The Waste Management bill is up for renewal. We need to check on prices from other services. J. Lippert was to look into this. Jim Heinlein will not be at the August and September meeting.
