


PRAYER FOR THE NEW YEAR



FROM THE PASTOR

I want to commend you for the giving and outreach you have carried out the last months of 2025. In November you filled over 90 shoe boxes to go overseas to children for Christmas. We surpassed our international missions goal! This will help support 3500 missionaries. We provided Thanksgiving food baskets for four families. We offered a Christmas Vacation Bible School to twenty -two children in Amelia. We provided \$1105.00 for the Amelia Christmas Father. We adopted 25 children from Amelia for Christmas providing them with both gifts and a Christmas Day dinner for them and their families. We partnered with Amelia High School wrestling team to provide snack and sponsored a basketball team through Amelia Parks and Rec. We also went caroling to shut-ins.

Thanks for all you did to make so much happen and touch lives from Amelia to parts of the world we do not even know of. God will use all of this to his glory!

When I served this church in the 80's as a youth minister I was impressed with the emphasis on missions and the impact a rural church could make. You are keeping that commitment alive and well. Blessings!

Our theme verse for 2026 is Romans 1:16 "For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek."

This year will provide us with many opportunities local and beyond to share the Gospel. We do not need to be ashamed of that Gospel. The Gospel being the Good News that Jesus came, died, was buried, and rose from the dead. Therein is the power of God that will bring people to him. Let's continue to share the gospel at every opportunity in 2026!

The Lord is providing funding for the South Hampton Roads Mission Project (SHRMP) as well as many locations for Vacation Bible Schools in the Hampton Roads area. SHRMP will be June 20-27. Please pray about going. Our greatest need is for workers. Jesus said to pray the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into the harvest.


