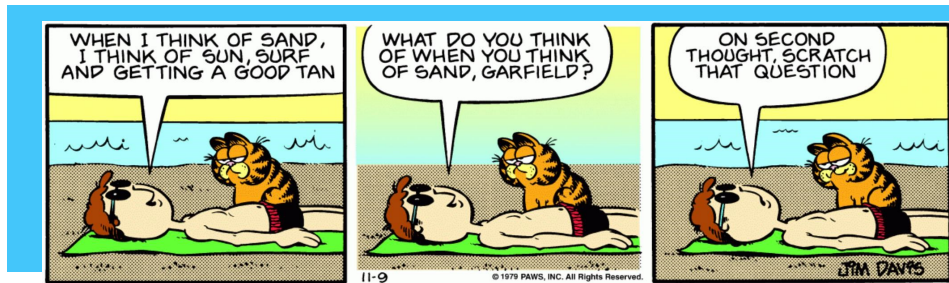

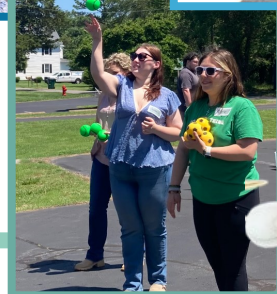

This event is more than just a meet-and greet - it's a chance to come together, hear Coach Neal's vision for the program, and get fired up for the upcoming season!

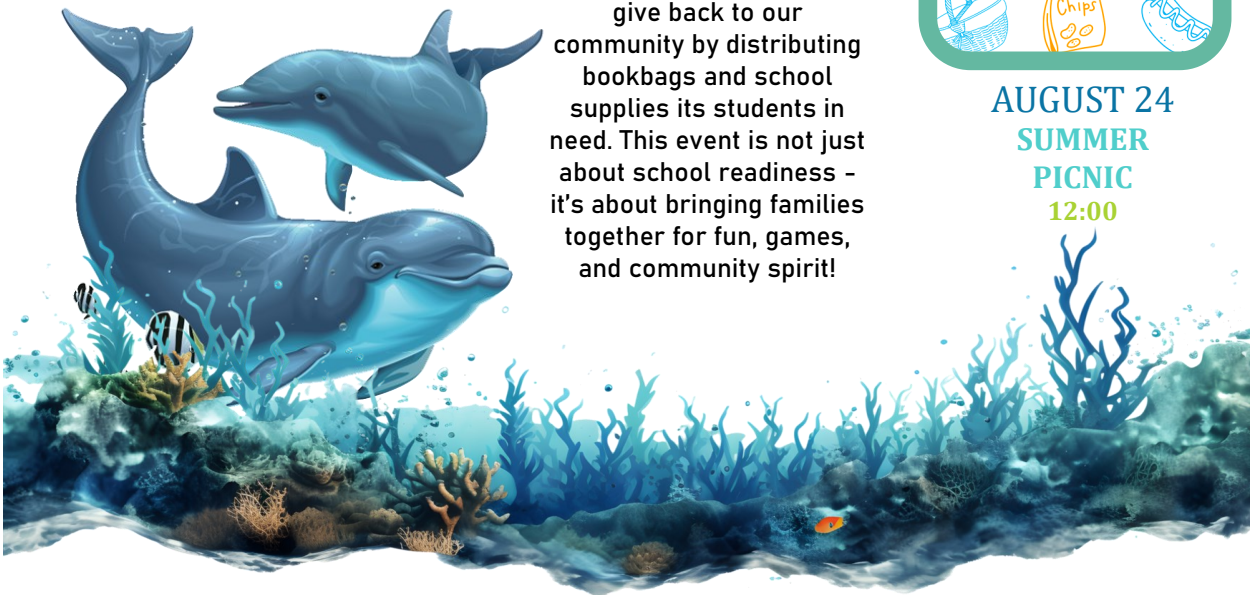

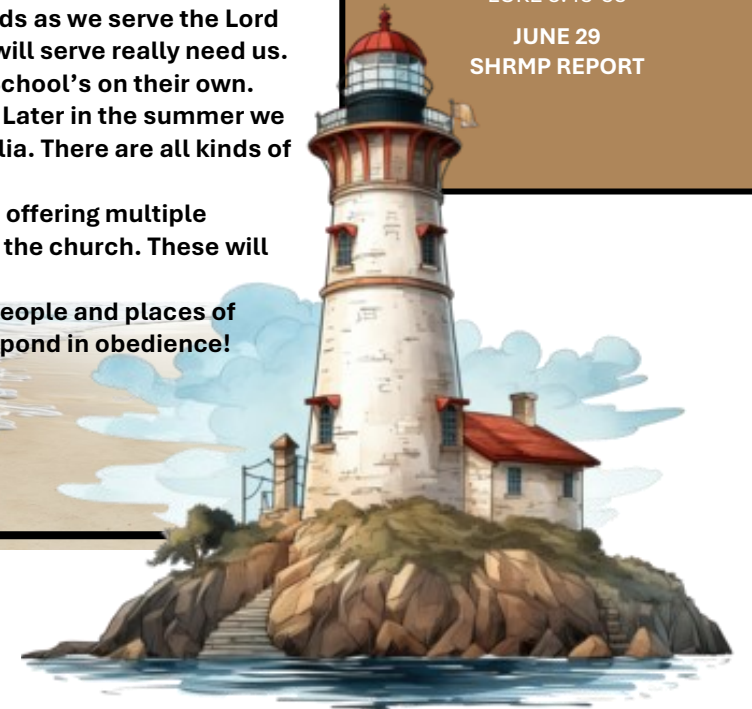

FINANCE

The finance committee has been diligent in prayer and watchful to the financial health of Amelia Baptist Church. With this as our concern we offer the following;

Giving has averaged \$16,950 and expenses have averaged \$16,514 over the first quarter of this year. With the roof repair work done the 4th quarter of last year we expended all of our operating reserve (C.D.s amounting to over \$56,000) and with the current rate of giving we have not been able to build up any reserve funds.

We are aware of pending financial needs and are preparing several motions for the June business meeting being proactive in our planning approach. We ask for your prayers and support.
